



AN ORDINANCE CREATING REQUIREMENTS FOR THE ISSUANCE OF ELECTRICAL, MECHANICAL AND PLUMBING LICENSES, CREATION OF AN ELECTRICAL BOARD OF REVIEW, PROVIDING LICENSING FEES, PROVIDING RESPECTIVE BOARD OF REVIEWS, PROVIDING LICENSING FEES, PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF, DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY FOR DAMAGE BY THE CITY AND RELATED PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Petal, Mississippi, is authorized by the Mississippi Constitution and the Mississippi Code to exercise its police powers in order to preserve the general public safety and welfare of its citizens;

Now, therefore, the City of Petal, Mississippi, do hereby enact and ordain the following to be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen:

SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

This Ordinance shall be known and may be cited as the Building Department Licensing Ordinance.

Before any license is issued, the applicant shall meet the following requirements:

3. The examiners shall be sworn in by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen.
4. The examiners shall be subject to removal by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen.

Before any license is issued, the applicant shall meet the following requirements:

- 1. The applicant shall be at least 18 years of age.
2. The applicant shall be a Mississippi resident who has resided in the State of Mississippi for at least one year immediately preceding the date of application.
3. The applicant shall have completed the following requirements:
a. Completion of a minimum of 100 hours of classroom instruction in the trade for which the license is sought.
b. Completion of a minimum of 100 hours of on-the-job training in the trade for which the license is sought.
c. Completion of a minimum of 100 hours of practical experience in the trade for which the license is sought.
d. Completion of a minimum of 100 hours of continuing education in the trade for which the license is sought.

Before any license is issued, the applicant shall meet the following requirements:

- 1. The applicant shall be at least 18 years of age.

3. The members shall be sworn in by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen.
4. The members shall be subject to removal by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen.

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Before any license is issued, the applicant shall meet the following requirements:
