- II. Environmental Justice

- The estimated amount of the ad valorem taxes and other anticipated revenues from local sources to be collected for the City is less than the amount estimated at the time of formulation of the City budget for the fiscal year due to circumstances which were unanticipated at the time of the formulation of the budget and which will prevent the City from meeting its financial obligations.
- The shortfall of ad valorem taxes and other anticipated revenue from local sources is estimated to be \$500,000 which shortfall does not exceed twenty-five percent (25%) of the budget anticipated to be funded from the sources of the shortfall for the fiscal year.
