ORDINANCE NUMBER 1979 (42-A353)

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CERTAIN SECTIONS OF ORDINANCE 1979(42) OF THE COMPREHENSIVE ZONING REGULATIONS FOR THE CITY OF PETAL, MISSISSIPPI, AMENDING ARTICLE XI. PLANNING COMMISSION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF PETAL, MISSISSIPPI:

SECTION 1: The following article of Ordinance 1979 (42) be amended as follows:

ARTICLE XI. PLANNING COMMISSION

11.0 - Establishment and Organization of Planning Commission

1. A Planning Commission is hereby established (Mississippi Code 1972, § 17-1-11)
2. The Planning Commission shall consist of ten (10) members, all of whom must be citizen members representing their respective wards, with the exception of the two (2) at-large positions whom must be citizen members residing in any ward within the City of Petal city limits.
3. Planning Commission members shall serve with pay at the rate of \$100.00 per month upon attending all scheduled and special meetings.
4. The Mayor and Board of Aldermen shall be the appointing authority of the Planning Commission. There shall be two (2) commissioners appointed per ward, and two (2) at-large commissioners. Individuals applying for a Planning Commission vacancy shall submit a resume to the alderman representing the ward where the vacancy exists. Upon review of resumes, the alderman shall submit a name for consideration by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen. Applicants must reside in the ward where the vacancy exists, except where the vacancy exists for the at-large positions.

11.2 Meetings of the Planning Commission; Quorum; Minutes; Subpoena Power; Administration of Oaths.

1. The Planning Commission shall conduct meetings on the 2nd and 4th Tuesday of every month at 6:00 P.M. in the place designated for such meetings.

SECTION 2. Except as hereby expressly changed and amended, the aforesaid Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance No. 1979 (42) of the City of Petal, Mississippi, shall be and remain in full force.
