



AN ORDINANCE OUTLAWING SYNTHETIC CANNABINOIDS OR OTHER SYNTHETIC PRODUCTS WITHIN THE CITY OF PETAL.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF PETAL, MISSISSIPPI, AS FOLLOWS, TO-WIT:

EXHIBIT "C"

possession, purchase, distribution or sale or the attempt to use, possess, purchase, distribute or sale or publicly display for sale the aforementioned substances.

SECTION 1:

No person shall use, possess, purchase, distribute, sale or attempt to use, possess, purchase, distribute or sale or publicly display for sale any one (1) or more of the following chemicals within the city limits of the City of Petal, Mississippi:

- (1) Salviadinorum or salvivorum A: All parts of the plant presently classified botanically as Salsvia divinorum, whether growing or not, the seeds thereof an extract from any part of such plant, and every compound, manufacture salts derivative, mixture or preparation of such plant, its seeds or extracts;
- (2) (6aR,10aR)-9-(hydroxymethyl)-6,6dimethyl-3-(2-methyloctan-2-yl)-6a7,10-10a-tetrahydrobenzo[*c*]chromen-1-01 some trade or other names: THU-210;
- (3) 1-Pentyl-3-(1-naphthoyl) indole-some trade or other names: JWH-018/spice;
- (4) 1-Butyl-3-(1-naphthoyl) indole-some trade or other names: JWH-073;
- (5) 1-(3-[trifluoromethylphenyl]) piperazine-some trade or other names: TFMIP;
- (6) 4-methoxymethylcathinone, methylcathinone and ethylcathinone;
- (7) 3,4-Methylenedioxyprovalerone, and related analogs, known by the trade name or other names such as MDPV;
- (8) 2-[(1R,3S)-3-hydroxycyclohexyl]-5-(2-methyloctan-2-yl) Phenol, and related homologues known by trade name or other names such as CP 47,497 or Spice;
- (9) Any structural analogs similar to those specified in (1) through (8); and
- (10) Any other synthetic cannabinoid including, but not limited to, those substances known by the trade names of Spice, K2 or Mojo.

SECTION 2:

If any of the aforementioned substances shall be found in the possession of any person, unless specifically excluded herein, the substances shall be confiscated and destroyed by law enforcement officials.

SECTION 3:

SECTION 4:

This ordinance shall not apply to any person who shall commit any act described in this Ordinance, pursuant to the direction or prescription of a duly licensed physician or dentist authorized to direct or prescribe such act. This Ordinance shall not apply to the inhalation of anesthesia for a medical or dental purpose which inhalation of anesthesia shall be administered by or under the supervision of a duly licensed physician or dentist.

SECTION 5:

Any person found to be guilty of violating this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine not to exceed one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00), or imprisoned in the county jail not to exceed six (6) months or both.

SECTION 6:

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen having found that an emergency does exist in the City of Petal due to the aforementioned substances, this Ordinance shall be effective immediately from and after its passage.

The above and foregoing Ordinance having been reduced to writing, the same was read and voted again, first section by section and then upon the Ordinance as a whole.


