BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF PETAL, MISSISSIPPI:

SECTION 1:

It shall be unlawful for any sales of food or food products or garden and laws supplies to be made in the City of Petel, Hississippi, on a Sunday, other than those items which shall be sold in an establishment with not more than 2400 sq. ft. of sales space and have not more than three amployees at any one time, including the owner, operator, or proprietor of such establishment, provided, however, that no sales of the aforesaid items may be made in the City of Petal, Mississippi, between the hours of one o'clock A.H. and twelve o'clock noon on a Sunday.

For the purpose of this ordinance, the words "sales space", as set furth in Section 1 above, shall include that space in such establishment, not only which is open to the public, but also that space where refrigerators, vending machines and meats or other food products are displayed to the public.

SECTION 3:

The limitations of this ordinance shall not apply to restaurants or sellers of prepared foods or beverages for onsumption on or off the premises.

SECTION 4:

It shall be unlawful for any sales to be made in the City of Petal, Mississippi, in violation of the laws of the State of Hississippi.
