

ORDINANCE NO. 3530

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESA, ARIZONA, AMENDING THE CITY CODE BY ADDING A SECTION PERTAINING TO OBSTRUCTING A FIRE LANE TO TITLE 10, CHAPTER 3; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, ARIZONA:

Section 1: That a new section of the Mesa City Code be added as follows:

10-3-21(M) – OBSTRUCTING A FIRE LANE - THE REQUIRED WIDTH OF ACCESS ROADWAYS SHALL NOT BE OBSTRUCTED IN ANY MANNER. NO PERSON SHALL STOP, STAND OR PARK ANY VEHICLE WITHIN A FIRE LANE, WHETHER ON PUBLIC OR PRIVATE PROPERTY, PROVIDED THAT APPROPRIATE SIGNS AND OTHER MARKINGS, AS APPROVED BY THE FIRE CHIEF, SHALL BE ERECTED AND MAINTAINED IN ORDER FOR THIS REGULATION TO BE EFFECTIVE.

Section 2: That the Schedule of Sanctions found in 10-3-25(E) be changed by deleting the reference to “Section 7-2-2(M)” and replacing it with Section “10-3-21(M)”.


Section 3: If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance or any part of these amendments is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions.
