

Commission Meeting Minutes
November 19, 2024
5:30 pm

Mayor Redding called the meeting to order at 5:30 pm.

Members in attendance included Mayor Andy Redding, Commissioner Bob Milner, Commissioner Janice D. Mortimer and Commissioner Danny Nugent. Also in attendance were Attorney Danielle Adams, Executive Assistant Cathy Bradley, Deputy Clerk Lisa Heeder, Finance Director James Hughes, Captain Kevin Mueller and General Manager Drew Mullins. Commissioner Scott Roberts was absent.

Mayor Redding asked if there were any agenda changes, additions or deletions. There were none. Mayor Redding entertained a motion to approve the agenda. Commissioner Mortimer made a motion to approve the agenda. It was seconded by Commissioner Nugent. The motion passed 4-0.

Mayor Redding called for the consent agenda. The consent agenda consisted of the Minutes of the November 5, 2024 Commission Meeting, Resolution Number 2025-05 authorizing the mayor and certain city staff to sign the Community Development Block Grant Coronavirus Category (CDBG-CV), Resolution Number 2025-06 agreement with the Florida Department of Commerce for Community Planning Technical Assistance and the commissioner bill review. Mayor Redding entertained a motion to approve the consent agenda. Commissioner Milner made a motion. It was seconded by Commissioner Mortimer. The motion passed 4-0.

There was no old business.

There were no emergency items.

There were no citizens requests.

Mayor Redding called for public hearings. Paul Still presented the Bradford Soil and Water Conservation District presentation to discuss the Edwards Bottomlands Project. Mr. Still talked about the issues with Alligator Creek flooding and potential elevated radium levels from Chemours discharges.

Mayor Redding called for the general manager's report. Mr. Mullins had nothing.

Mayor Redding called for the chief administrative officer report. Mr. Hughes had nothing.

Mayor Redding called for the city attorney report. Attorney Adams said their ethics training is December 18th. She is putting together a letter concerning new legislation.

Captain Mueller handed out the Law Enforcement Report for April through September 2024.
