

Commission Meeting Minutes
February 4, 2025
5:30 pm

Mayor Redding called the meeting to order at 5:30 pm.

Members in attendance included Mayor Andy Redding, Commissioner Bob Milner, Commissioner Janice D. Mortimer and Commissioner Scott Roberts. Also in attendance were Executive Assistant Cathy Bradley, Chief Administrative Officer Jimmy Crosby, Attorney Allison Folds, Executive Assistant Lisa Heeder, James Hughes, Captain Kevin Mueller and General Manager Drew Mullins. Commissioner Danny Nugent was absent.

Mayor Redding asked if there were any agenda changes, additions or deletions. Hearing none, Mayor Redding entertained a motion to approve.
