RESOLUTION **15-25**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MUNCIE  
ESTABLISHING A COMMITTEE TO STUDY THE DEVELOPMENT OF A  
COMMUNITY CENTER TO REPLACE THE FORMER SOUTH MADISON  
COMMUNITY CENTER**

WHEREAS, the South Madison Community Center, familiarly known as The Multi, was razed in 2006 in conjunction with the Hope 6 grant, with the caveat that a new community center ("Community Center") would be built during Phase 1 of the building of the Millenium Place residential development project; and

WHEREAS, the Hope 6 grant was later modified and the promise to replace the Community Center was removed; and

WHEREAS, the Industry neighborhood in particular, and the City of Muncie as a whole, was greatly distressed at the loss of such a Community Center, especially our children; and

WHEREAS, the City of Muncie lost an important gathering place that provided intellectual, physical and spiritual programming and a safe space for our City's children, as well as assistance for working parents; and

WHEREAS, the City of Muncie over multiple administrations has made promises to the community that the Community Center would be replaced; and

WHEREAS, youth attending local information gatherings and educational programs overwhelmingly cite having a community center in their neighborhoods as their most important need; and

WHEREAS, multiple studies have shown community centers can have a stabilizing effect on the lives of young people as well as their surrounding communities; and

WHEREAS, a report from the University of Chicago links afterschool programs, such as those afforded by "The Multi", with reduced drug use; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Muncie desires to create a committee to study the contingencies of building a new Community Center; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE  
CITY OF MUNCIE AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1 – Establishment of Committee: There is hereby created the Community Center Development Advisory Committee ("Committee").

Section 2 – Appointments of Committee: The Committee shall consist of the following seven (7) individuals:

- A member of the Common Council to be appointed by a majority vote of the Common Council.

- The President of the Southside Neighborhood Association or his/her designee.
- The President of the Morningside Neighborhood Association or his/her designee.
- The Mayor of the City of Muncie.
- The President of the South Central Neighborhood Association or his/her designee.
- The President of the Industry Neighborhood Association or his/her designee.
- The President of the Blaine Neighborhood Association or his/her designee.

Section 3 – Duration of Committee: The Committee shall remain in existence until such time that a Community Center is completed or until termination by resolution of the Common Council of the City of Muncie.

Section 4 – Duties of Committee: The Committee shall be responsible for obtaining public input and advising the City of Muncie regarding the development of a Community Center. The Committee’s duties shall include, but not necessarily be limited to, considering the feasibility of developing a Community Center in a vacant building located at Heekin Park as proposed by the Mayor, exploring alternative locations for the development of a Community Center if necessary, advising the Mayor regarding the needed features and components of a Community Center, and identifying and exploring additional funding sources for the development of a Community Center.

Section 5 – Format of Meeting: The Committee shall be responsible for conducting meetings in compliance with the Indiana Open Door Law. Meetings shall be scheduled at a time and location that encourages public input and transparency.

Section 6 - This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from after its passage by the Common Council and its approval by the Mayor of the City of Muncie, Indiana.
