STANDARD RIGHT OF WAY PERMIT CONDITIONS

- 1. To advise the Central Oregon Coast Fire and Rescue District (COCFRD) in advance of any blocking of through traffic by such work, and the times of such restrictions. The telephone number for COCFRD is (541)563-3121.
- 2. To perform all excavation of street surfaces by means of T-cuts of asphalt.
- 3. To properly backfill the excavation immediately upon completion of the work below grade, compact to ODOT standards, and to repair the paving within days of date of permit in accordance with printed specifications, details and requirements of the Waldport Public Works department.
- 4. To hold the City of Waldport harmless against any and all liability, loss, cost, damage or expense which may accrue to the City because of the negligence or misconduct in the performance or lack of performance of any work by the permittee or my/our agent.
- 5. To guarantee the above street repair work for a period of one year from completion, to immediately repair same should the replacement fail during that period.
- 6. No excavation shall be left open overnight without adequate barricades, signs and lights as required by OR/OSHA standards, or further required by the City's Public Works Director.
- 7. No private driveway approach nor street intersection shall be blocked overnight, nor longer than is reasonable while construction is in progress.
- 8. The applicant shall furnish all signs and/or flagmen necessary for the control of traffic as required by OR/OSHA standards, or further required by the City's Public Works Director.
- 9. The applicant will restore all private approaches as to good, or better condition, than existed prior to construction.
- 10. Applicant has read Chapter 12.20 of the Waldport Municipal Code and agrees further to only excavate in those areas and at those depths previously authorized by the City's Public Works Director.
