

RESOLUTION NO. 1327

A RESOLUTION ACKNOWLEDGING THE AUTHORITY AND SECURITY OF CITY PROPERTY FOR COUNCILORS.

WHEREAS, the Waldport City Charter was adopted by the people in 1996;

WHEREAS, the Charter establishes the responsibilities of various officers and officials;

WHEREAS, Charter title 21 (d)(6) specifically grants authority over city property to the City Manager;

WHEREAS, a council member who attempts to violate that authority puts staff and city resources at risk:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Waldport:

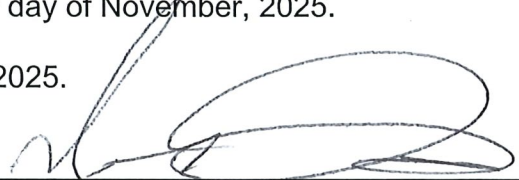
Be it the Policy of the City of Waldport

All Council members acknowledge and are required to adhere to the following:

- 1) No Councilor shall access or has the individual authority to grant access to any city facility which is locked, secured or is used for city utility purposes without written permission. This includes any property, easement or access way.
- 2) Councilors requesting access must request such access from the city manager, or from the body of the entire Council at a council meeting.
- 3) No Councilor shall discuss, or inform others the security of any facility, nor give permission for others to access or trespass on any city property without the permissions above.
- 4) The City Manager shall not unreasonably deter access to any elected official.
- 5) Violation of this policy may be, after review of council, be considered a misuse of official position resulting in a citation for criminal trespass or other charges as appropriate.
