
ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 20.58 OF THE DEL NORTE COUNTY



THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF DEL NORTE, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section One. This ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after its passage. Before the expiration of fifteen (15) days after its passage, a summary of it shall be published once, with the names of the members voting for and against the same, in a local newspaper of general circulation in the County of Del Norte, State of California.

Section Two. Section 20.58.015 is hereby added to Chapter 20.58 of the Del Norte County Ordinance Code to read in its entirety as follows:

20.58.015 Payment of Filing Fee

The notice of appeal required by section 20.58.010 shall be accompanied by payment of the fee required by resolution of the board of supervisors. The notice of appeal shall not be deemed filed unless accompanied by the fee required by resolution of the board of supervisors.

Section Three: If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion of this ordinance. The Board of Supervisors hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance and each section, subsection, clause or phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional.
