AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 20 OF THE DEL NORTE COUNTY ORDINANCE CODE AND TITLE 21 OF THE LOCAL COASTAL PROGRAM ZONING ENABLING ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF DEL NORTE PERMITTING ANIMAL HUSBANDRY IN RESIDENTIAL AND AGRICULTURAL, FOREST-RECREATION, FOREST AND RECREATION, AND VARIOUS RURAL RESIDENTIAL ZONING DISTRICTS

The following ordinance, consisting of fifteen sections, was duly and regularly passed and adopted by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Del Norte, State of California, at a regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors held on the 10th day of January, 1995, by the following vote:

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF DEL NORTE, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section One. This ordinance, shall take effect no sooner than thirty (30) days after its passage. Before the expiration of fifteen (15) days after its passage, a summary of it shall be published once, with the names of the members voting for and against the same, in a local newspaper of general circulation in the County of Del Norte, State of California.

Section Two: Section 20.12A.010, subdivision (G), of the Del Norte County Ordinance Code is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

G. Animal Husbandry, where no more than one horse, mule, cow or steer, nor more than five goats, sheep or similar livestock are kept for each twenty thousand (20,000) square feet of lot area.

Section Three: Section 20.13.020, subdivision (C), of the Del Norte County Ordinance Code is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

C. Animal Husbandry, where no more than one horse, mule, cow or steer, nor more than five goats, sheep or similar livestock are kept for each twenty thousand (20,000) square feet of lot area.

Section Four: Subdivision (E) is hereby added to Section 20.15.020 of the Del Norte County Ordinance Code to read in its entirety as follows:

E. Animal Husbandry, where no more than one horse, mule, cow or steer, nor more than five goats, sheep or similar

livestock are kept for each twenty thousand (20,000) square feet of lot area.

Section Five: Subdivision (E) of Section 20.15.030 of the Del Norte County Ordinance Code is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

E. Animal Husbandry, where more than one horse, mule, cow or steer, or more than five goats, sheep or similar livestock are kept for each twenty thousand (20,000) square feet of lot area.

Section Six: Subdivision (C) is hereby added to Section 20.17.010 of the Del Norte County Ordinance Code to read in its entirety as follows:

C. Animal Husbandry, where no more than one horse, mule, cow or steer, nor more than five goats, sheep or similar livestock are kept for each twenty thousand (20,000) square feet of lot area.

Section Seven: Subdivision (G) is hereby added to Section 20.34.010 of the Del Norte County Ordinance Code to read in its entirety as follows:

G. Animal Husbandry, where no more than one horse, mule, cow or steer, nor more than five goats, sheep or similar livestock are kept for each twenty thousand (20,000) square feet of lot area.

Section Eight: Subdivision (D) of Section 20.34.020 of the Del Norte County Ordinance Code is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

D. Animal Husbandry, where more than one horse, mule, cow or steer, or more than five goats, sheep or similar

livestock are kept for each twenty thousand (20,000) square feet of lot area.

Section Nine: Subdivision (K) is hereby added to Section 20.35.020 of the Del Norte County Ordinance Code to read in its entirety as follows:

K. Animal Husbandry, where no more than one horse, mule, cow or steer, nor more than five goats, sheep or similar livestock are kept for each twenty thousand (20,000) square feet of lot area.

Section Ten: Subdivision (M) of Section 20.35.030 of the Del Norte County Ordinance Code is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

M. Animal Husbandry, where more than one horse, mule, cow or steer, or more than five goats, sheep or similar livestock are kept for each twenty thousand (20,000) square feet of lot area.

Section Eleven: Subdivision (C) is hereby added to Section 21.16.020 of the Local Coastal Program Zoning Enabling Ordinance of the County of Del Norte to read in its entirety as follows:

C. Animal Husbandry, where no more than one horse, mule, cow or steer, nor more than five goats, sheep or similar livestock are kept for each twenty thousand (20,000) square feet of lot area.

Section Twelve: Subdivision (C) of Section 21.16.030 of the Local Coastal Program Zoning Enabling Ordinance of the County of Del Norte is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

C. Animal Husbandry, where more than one horse, mule, cow or steer, or more than five goats, sheep or similar

livestock are kept for each twenty thousand (20,000) square feet of lot area.

Section Thirteen: Subdivision (B) of Section 21.17.020 of the Local Coastal Program Zoning Enabling Ordinance of the County of Del Norte is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

C. Animal Husbandry, where no more than one horse, mule, cow or steer, nor more than five goats, sheep or similar livestock are kept for each twenty thousand (20,000) square feet of lot area.

Section Fourteen: Subdivision (A) of Section 21.17.030 of the Local Coastal Program Zoning Enabling Ordinance of the County of Del Norte is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

A. On parcels of land five acres or greater in size, the following may be considered subject to the approval of the county sanitarian:

1. Animal Husbandry, where more than one horse, mule, cow or steer, or more than five goats, sheep or similar livestock are kept for each twenty thousand (20,000) square feet of lot area;
2. More than one hog or pig.

Section Fifteen: If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion of this ordinance. The Board of Supervisors hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance and each section, subsection, clause or phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional.
