



AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 20.48 OF THE DEL NORTE COUNTY ORDINANCE CODE AND CHAPTER 21.46 OF THE LOCAL COASTAL PROGRAM ZONING ENABLING ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF DEL NORTE PERMITTING ANIMALS IN RESIDENTIAL ZONES AS RECOGNIZED YOUTH GROUP PROJECTS

The following ordinance, consisting of four sections, was duly and regularly passed and adopted by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Del Norte, State of California, at a regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors held on the 10th day of January, 199 ⁵, by the following vote:



THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF DEL NORTE, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section One. This ordinance, shall take effect no sooner than thirty (30) days after its passage. Before the expiration of fifteen (15) days after its passage, a summary of it shall be published once, with the names of the members voting for and against the same, in a local newspaper of general circulation in the County of Del Norte, State of California.

Section Two: Section 20.48.110, subdivision (D) of the Del Norte County Ordinance Code and Section 21.46.110, subdivision (D) of the Local Coastal Program Zoning Enabling Ordinance of the County of Del Norte are hereby amended to read in their entirety as follows:

D. No portion of a pen, cage or shelter for the animal(s) shall be located closer to a neighboring residence than to the one in which the project participant dwells.

Section Three: Section 20.48.110, subdivision (E) of the Del Norte County Ordinance Code and Section 21.46.110, subdivision (E) of the Local Coastal Program Zoning Enabling Ordinance of the County of Del Norte are hereby amended to read in their entirety as follows:

E. No health hazard or neighborhood nuisance is created.

Section Four. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion of this ordinance. The Board of Supervisors

hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance and each section, subsection, clause or phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional.
