ORDINANCE NO. 69-4

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 67-10 COMMONLY KNOWN AS THE COUNTY ZONING ENABLING ORDINANCE, CONCERNING ON-SITE SIGNS IN RH, C, AND M DISTRICTS.

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Del Norte, State of California, do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Del Norte County Ordinance No. 67-10, known as the Zoning Enabling Ordinance, is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION 2. The first sentence of paragraph (b) of subsection 5.0103 relative to signs having an aggregate area of 40 square feet is hereby deleted and replaced with the following:

Signs which are appurtenant to any permitted use may be displayed in any RH, C, or M District, provided that no more than three (3) signs of not more than 2 square feet of area per foot of frontage to a maximum of 200 square feet of aggregate area shall be permitted for any one establishment. Where double faced signs are used, the area of one side only shall be included in the aggregate area. Lot frontage used in determining sign areas shall include property frontage where in the main entrance to the business is located. Where a public or private parking lot is adjacent to a business, only the frontage whereon the business is conducted shall be counted as business frontage.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days after the date of its passage and approval.
