ORDINANCE NO. 70-7

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 67-10 COMMONLY KNOWN AS THE COUNTY ZONING ENABLING ORDINANCE CONCERNING CONTRACTOR YARDS, LUMBER YARDS, AND STORAGE YARDS.

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Del Norte, State of California, does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Del Norte County Ordinance No. 67-10, known as the Zoning Enabling Ordinance is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION 2. Paragraph (b) of subsection 3.1201 is hereby amended by omitting the words "contractor yards, lumber yards" from the text.

Paragraph (f) of subsection 3.1202 is hereby added, reading as follows: (f) Contractor yards, lumber yards, storage yards.

Paragraph (h) of subsection 3.1302 is hereby amended to read as follows: (h) Junk yards, wrecking yards, contractor yards, lumber yards, and storage yards.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days after the date of its passage and approval.
