NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Ocala, Florida as follows:

Section 1. That Sections 58-170 and 58-171 of the Code of Ordinances, City of Ocala, Florida, are hereby repealed in its entirety.

<u>Section 2</u>. Severability Clause: Should any provision or section of this ordinance be held by a court of competent jurisdiction to be held unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole, or any part thereof, other than the part so declared to be unconstitutional or invalid.

<u>Section 3</u>. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

<u>Section 4</u>. This ordinance shall take effect upon approval by the mayor, or upon becoming law without such approval.
