

ORDINANCE NO. 20-4433

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Decatur, Alabama as follows:

Section 1. That Section 3-32 of the CODE OF DECATUR, ALABAMA is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 3-32. - Performance bond.

“Prior to commencing operations and at all times thereafter, provider shall have in full force and effect a performance bond in the amount of two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000.00) secured by a reputable bonding agency protecting the city from any loss as a result of the failure of the provider to provide ambulance service in the city and providing the city the funds necessary to provide alternate ambulance service in the event the provider ceases operation in the city. If provider ceases operation in the city prior to the natural expiration of its CPNC for any reason, including the revocation of the CPNC by the city, the full bond amount will immediately become due and payable to the city. The bond shall not be canceled without the consent of the city and the city shall be notified immediately of any delinquent payment or attempt by the provider to cancel, alter or terminate the bond or to change the beneficiary. Proceeds from the performance bond will be used to pay all costs of obtaining and providing for the provision of ambulance services from the time the provider ceases operation until a replacement commences business. Such costs may be include payments to the interim CPNC holder for additional equipment and personnel costs and may include additional cost to the city to provide such service. The above notwithstanding the provider shall be initially allowed until December 31, 2020 to have in force and effect the required performance bond.”

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval and publication as provided by law.


