Ordinance No.: 4929

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SWEETWATER, FLORIDA AMENDING SECTION 2-380 OF THE CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES TO PROVIDE FOR REMOVAL OF ADVISORY BOARD MEMBERS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; PROVIDING FOR EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City has a number of advisory boards; and,

WHEREAS, members of advisory boards are appointed by City Commissioners; and,

WHEREAS, it is in the interests of the residents to ensure the board members are answerable to the commissioners who appoint them;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SWEETWATER, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The above preamble is incorporated herein by reference as if set forth in full.

Section 2. Section 2-380(c) is hereby amended by the <u>addition of underscored language</u> and <u>deletion of stricken-through language</u>, as follows:

Sec. 2-380. - Appointments, vacancies, resignations, qualifications, terms of office.

(c)The term of each board member shall coincide with the term of the appointing commissioner. Notwithstanding the preceding sentence, a sitting board member shall continue to serve until an appointment is made after either an election or a vacancy in a city office.

Members serve at the pleasure of their appointing commissioner. An appointing commissioner may remove his or her appointed board member at any regularly scheduled city commission meeting with or without notice. There shall be no term limits.

The appointing commissioner, may remove his or her appointed board member at any regularly scheduled city commission meeting, subject to confirmation of a majority of the city commission. There shall be no term limits.

Section 3. All ordinances or portions of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Sweetwater in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be repealed upon the effective date hereof.

Section 4. It is the intention of the Mayor and the City Commission that the provisions of this ordinance be incorporated into the Code of Ordinances; to effect such intention codifiers may change the words "ordinance" or "section" to other appropriate words.

Section 5. If any portion of this ordinance is held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity shall not affect the remaining portions of the ordinance.

Section 6. This ordinance shall become effective upon its adoption by the City Commission and approval by the Mayor or, if vetoed, upon its reenactment by the City Commission as provided by the Charter of the City of Sweetwater.
