



**Ordinance No.
2020-161**

An ordinance amending Chapter 24 of the Victoria City Code to adopt Residential Building Permit Fees and Commercial Building Permit Fees, repealing all conflicting ordinances, providing for codification and savings, and declaring an effective date.

Whereas this amendment decreases the Residential Building Permit fee in Section 24-44; and

Whereas this amendment increases the Commercial Building Permit fees in Section 24-45;

Now therefore, be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Victoria, Texas:

1. That the following section of Chapter 24 of the Victoria City Code is hereby amended as follows:

Section 24-44 - Residential Building Permit Fees:

(c) Residential Remodel and Repair: The residential remodel and repair building permit shall be ~~\$0.20~~ *\$0.10* per square foot or \$80.00, whichever is greater. Separate building trade permits are required and will be issued at the applicable charge. All other fees shall be charged as an additional fee; and

Section 24-45 - Commercial Building Permit Fees:

For all types of construction other than one- and two-family residential:

Total Valuation

Up to \$1000	\$100.00 <i>\$120.00</i>
\$1,001 to \$15,000 fraction thereof	\$100.00 <i>\$120.00</i> for the first \$1,000, plus \$6.00 for each additional thousand or fraction thereof
\$15,001 to \$50,000 fraction thereof	\$184.00 <i>\$204.00</i> for the first \$1,000, plus \$5.00 for each additional thousand or fraction thereof
\$50,001 to \$100,000 fraction thereof	\$359.00 <i>\$379.00</i> for the first \$1,000, plus \$3.80 for each additional thousand or fraction thereof
\$100,001 to \$500,000 fraction thereof	\$549.00 <i>\$569.00</i> for the first \$1,000, plus \$2.35 for each additional thousand or fraction thereof
\$500,001 and up or fraction thereof	\$1,489.00 <i>\$1,509.00</i> for the first \$1,000, plus \$1.25 for each additional thousand or fraction thereof

2. All parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are repealed to the extent of such conflict.
3. It is the intention of the City Council that this ordinance shall become a part of the Code of the City of Victoria, Texas, and it may be renumbered and codified therein accordingly, in the manner approved by the City Attorney. The Code of the City of Victoria, Texas, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect, save and except as amended by this ordinance.
4. If any provision of this ordinance, or the application thereof to any person or circumstances, shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity shall not affect the other provisions, or application thereof, of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable.
5. This ordinance shall become effective 10 days after final passage and approval by the City Council of the City of Victoria, Texas.


