AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE CITY OF ROCHESTER

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 54-206
OF CHAPTER 54 OF THE CODE OF THE
CITY OF ROCHESTER

THE CITY OF ROCHESTER ORDAINS:

Sec. 54-206. Water rate schedule - Detroit Service District.

(a) Generally. The following schedule of water rates is hereby established and shall be charged for water supplied to the area within the City identified as the Detroit Water Service District, which is water supplied by the Charter Township of Shelby from the City of Detroit Water Department by agreement with the City of Rochester. The charge for the water will be in accordance with the following rate structure:

\$3.85 per 100 cubic feet of water, with a minimum charge of \$71.30 except for multifamily residential units on one meter. Multifamily residential units shall be subject to a minimum charge of \$71.30 for the first unit and 50% of the minimum charge for each additional unit.

(b) Special rates. Rates for flat rate supply, for special supply, or for temporary supply for any purpose shall be fixed by the City Manager and shall not be less than the minimum charge.

(c) Premises outside corporate limits. The rates for water supplied for all premises outside the corporate limits of the City of Rochester shall be 150% of the rates listed above.

(d) Temporary fire hydrant.

The hydrant connection will be issued by the water department. The use of a privately owned hydrant connection is prohibited. The unused portion of the deposited fee will be refunded to the user upon return of the hydrant connection, less any amounts due to the city for water usage.

This Ordinance shall become effective beginning upon publication.
