

ORDINANCE NO. 016-02

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CENTRALIA MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING THE AMENDMENT OF CHAPTER 4 SECTION 4-4 SUBSECTION (B) REGARDING EMPLOYMENT OF INDIVIDUALS UNDER THE AGE OF TWENTY ONE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CENTRALIA, ILLINOIS, that:

SECTION ONE: Subsection (b) of § 4-4 of Chapter 4 of the Centralia Municipal Code be and same is hereby amended to read as follows:

§ 4-4. Employees.

(b) No person licensed under this chapter shall employ in any premises used for the retail sale of alcoholic liquor any person under the age of twenty-one (21) years to draw, pour, mix, sell, serve, carry or deliver alcoholic liquor or allow a person under the age of twenty-one (21) to draw, pour, mix, sell, serve, carry or deliver alcoholic liquor. An exemption to this is allowed for those establishments that obtains at least 51% of their annual gross revenue from the sale of non-alcoholic beverages, non-alcoholic retail items or food. These establishments that qualify may allow those between eighteen (18) and twenty-one (21) to be employed and offer alcohol for sale, serve, carry or deliver alcoholic liquor until 10 p.m., but shall not allow them to draw, pour, or mix alcoholic liquor at any time until the age of 21. Until 10 p.m. those between eighteen (18) and twenty-one (21) are allowed to only serve, carry or deliver alcoholic liquor, but shall never draw, pour, or mix. After 10 p.m. these establishments may employ those between the ages of eighteen (18) and twenty-one (21), but shall not allow them to draw, pour, mix, sell, serve, carry or deliver alcoholic liquor. The local liquor control commissioner, at their discretion, may request additional documentation or an audit of any establishment's records conducted in accordance with generally accepted accounting procedures, by a certified public accountant, in order to prove compliance with this subsection. The cost of the audit shall be borne by the licensee.

SECTION TWO: In all other respects, the Centralia Municipal Code shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION THREE: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect ten days after its passage and publication as required by law.

SECTION FOUR: The City Clerk shall publish this ordinance in pamphlet form.
