

ORDINANCE NO. O19-23

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 21, ARTICLE 3, OF THE CENTRALIA MUNICIPAL CODE FOR MUNICIPAL COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL SERVICES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CENTRALIA, ILLINOIS, that:

SECTION ONE: Section 21-41 of Chapter 21 of the Centralia Municipal Code be and same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 21-41. - Generally.

- (a) The city shall collect all residential garbage, refuse, and rubbish from single family dwellings and duplexes. The collection shall be made by the city at least once each week. All said garbage, refuse and rubbish shall be stored for collection in containers as described in subsection (b).
- (b) For purposes of this section, containers shall include the following:
 - (1) 95 gallon trash cart provided by waste management company
 - (2) Galvanized metal pails or containers;
 - (3) Plastic pails or containers;
 - (4) Plastic garbage bags.

In no event shall those containers described herein exceed thirty-five (35) lbs. in weight except those provided by waste management company. All containers shall be closed and sealed with tightly fitting lids or properly tied. All solid containers shall be properly fitted with handles for lifting.

- (c) No person shall deposit in residential garbage, refuse and rubbish for collection by the city any hazardous waste or excluded waste per the contract with waste management company;
- (d) No person shall place for collection more than five (5) containers, as defined in subsection (b) of this section, per week per residence.
- (e) No person shall deposit for collection by the city any garbage not generated at the address from which the collection is made.

SECTION TWO: Section 21-42 of Chapter 21 of the Centralia Municipal Code be and same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 21-42. - Removal of brush or limbs.

- (a) The responsibility for removal of brush, limbs and other debris associated with the trimming or removal of trees and bushes on private property shall be with property owner. The city may remove same, provided it meets the following requirements:
 - (1) Loose limbs and brush shall be tied in bundles with a four-foot maximum length and weighing a maximum of thirty-five (35) pounds.
- (b) The city manager may schedule brush and limb pick up in advance on an area by area basis. Announcements as to area to be served shall be made to the news media at least one (1) week in advance of the scheduled pick up.
- (c) The city shall not provide pick up service on a continuing year around basis, but may provide such service on a periodic basis in the spring and fall. In addition, the city shall provide such pick up service following severe weather conditions resulting in major damage to trees. The required one-week notice to the public shall be waived in such instances.

SECTION THREE: Section 21-43 of Chapter 21 of the Centralia Municipal Code be and same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 21-43. - Service charge.

- a) The monthly rate for collection and disposal of garbage, refuse, rubbish and yard waste shall be the same rate as the contracted residential rate charged to the City of Centralia by the waste management company each month. A monthly service charge shall be imposed upon each single-family residence and each housekeeping unit of a duplex for collection of garbage, refuse, rubbish, and yard waste. The monthly rate for leaf vacuuming services is \$3.14 effective October 1, 2019 with a rate increase of 3% each year. The rate shall begin with the October billings each year. When yard waste collection and leaf collection services are not eligible for a specific location there will not be charges for those specific services. Said service charge shall be billed and paid with the water and sewer service charge. For those residences where there is not water and sewer services, each single-family residence shall be billed and paid bi-monthly. Residents cannot at any time select individual services.
- (b) If any such service charge is unpaid after the due date thereon, the city may cease collecting garbage, refuse, and ashes from the subject address until said fee is paid in full.
- (c) An annual service charge of four dollars and fifty cents (\$4.50) is imposed upon each single family residence and each housekeeping unit of a duplex less to cover expenses associated with the city-wide trash pickup. Said service charge shall be billed and paid with the first bill of each year with the water, sewer, and sanitation charge.

SECTION FOUR: Section 21-72 of Chapter 21 of the Centralia Municipal Code be and same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 21-72. - Curbside collection of residential yard waste.

- (a) The city shall provide curbside collection of yard waste for all single-family and multifamily residential properties within the corporate limits of Centralia. The collection of residential yard waste will be once a week per a schedule provided by the City.
- (b) Yard waste consisting of grass clippings and leaves shall be placed in biodegradable bags or reusable container with a capacity not to exceed 30 gallons.
- (c) Loose leaves must be placed curbside within 4 feet of the road for vacuumed collection according to the schedule and timeframes established by the City.
- (d) City collection of brush and limbs shall continue as specified in section 21-42 of article III of chapter 21.
- (e) A limit of ten (10) bags per residence per scheduled pick up shall be permitted. All bags shall be placed at the alley way or curbside as designated by the director of public works.
- (f) Yard waste not contained in an approved biodegradable bag(s) as specified in section 21-72(b) shall not be picked up by the city. It shall be the duty of the property owner or occupant or person in charge of any dwelling to properly dispose of the yard waste or rebag the waste for pick-up at the next scheduled collection date.
- (g) It shall be unlawful to place anything other than grass clippings, lawn rakings, garden vegetables, and leaves in the biodegradable bags for the purpose of collection and final disposal at the landscape waste reclamation facility.

SECTION FIVE: Section 21-73 of Chapter 21 of the Centralia Municipal Code be and same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 21-73. - Disposal of yard waste at landscape waste reclamation facility.

- (a) The city may establish and operate a landscape waste reclamation facility which will accept landscape and yard waste generated from within the corporate limits of the city as well as other communities and units of local government for which an intergovernmental agreement has been entered into with the city.
- (b) The public works director shall oversee the operation of the landscape waste reclamation facility and shall operate the facility in accordance with the requirements of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (IEPA) and shall obtain and maintain the required permits and submit an annual report as required by IEPA containing an estimate of the weight and volume of materials accepted at the facility for processing.
- (c) The city council shall establish by resolution rates and tipping fees for commercial users, residents and nonresidents of the city for disposal of landscape waste for processing at the facility. Said fee schedule shall be published as well as posted at the facility.
- (d) It shall be unlawful for any person or firm to deposit or dispose of any material other than yard and landscape materials as defined in section 1-71 of this article.

SECTION SIX: This Ordinance shall be in full force and affect as of October 1, 2019.

SECTION SEVEN: In all other respects, the Centralia Municipal Code shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION EIGHT: The City Clerk shall publish the Ordinance in pamphlet form.
