ORDINANCE NO. 2018-05 – ADOPTED 5-2-18

Notice is hereby given that at the regular meeting of the Bristol Town Council held on Wednesday evening, May 2, 2018, the following ordinance was adopted:

AN ORDINANCE IN AMENDMENT TO
CHAPTER 16 OF THE BRISTOL TOWN CODE

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the Town Council of Bristol, Rhode Island, that Chapter 16 of the Ordinances of the Town of Bristol be amended as follows:

CHAPTER 16 - MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC

ARTICLE V. - STOPPING, STANDING AND PARKING

Sec. 16-151. - Parking on Church Street and State Street Docks; violations and fines.

* * *

(c) It shall be unlawful for any person to park any vehicle overnight on the State Street Dock with the exception of those parking boats, trailers and material pursuant to section 16-158 of this chapter. Overnight is defined as a period of time from 12:00 midnight to 5:00 a.m.

(ed) Each person violating this section or any owner of a motor vehicle parked on State Street Dock or Church Street Dock in violation of this section shall be subject to a fine of \$25.00. Each and every day shall constitute a new offense. In addition to a fine, the chief of police is authorized to have any unauthorized vehicle and/or boat trailer towed to a suitable place within the town. Any motor vehicle thus removed shall be released to the owner, operator or other person having charge thereof only after payment of towing and storage charges.

(de) The entrance to State Street Dock and Church Street Dock shall be posted to the effect that parking is restricted to residents only, sticker is required, and all others are subject to tow away at the owner's expense and/or a \$25.00 fine.
