R-13 ORDINANCE NO. 49,602

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND REORDAIN SUBSECTION (B)(1) OF SECTION 25-233 OF THE NORFOLK CITY CODE, 1979, REGARDING PHOTO SPEED MONITORING DEVICES IN HIGHWAY WORK ZONES AND SCHOOL CROSSING ZONES, TO CONFIRM THE CIVIL PENALTY AS ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00).

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Norfolk:

Section 1:- That subsection (b)(1) of Section 25-233 of the Norfolk City Code, 1979, is hereby amended and reordained so as to amend the civil penalty to be one hundred dollars (\$100.00) and to read as follows:

- (b) As authorized by the City Manager, the Norfolk Police Department may place and operate photo speed monitoring devices within the boundaries of the City in school crossing zones for the purposes of recording violations of Code of Virginia § 46.2-873 and in highway work zones for the purposes of recording violations of Code of Virginia § 46.2-878.1.
- 1) The operator of a vehicle shall be liable for a monetary civil penalty imposed pursuant to this section if such vehicle is found, as evidenced by information obtained from a photo speed monitoring device, to be traveling at speeds of at least 10 miles per hour above the posted school crossing zone or highway work zone speed limit within such school crossing zone or highway work zone. Such civil penalty shall be one hundred dollars (\$100.00), and any prosecution shall be instituted and conducted in the same manner as prosecution for traffic infractions.

Civil penalties collected under this section resulting from a summons issued by a local law-enforcement officer shall be paid to the locality in which such violation occurred. Civil penalties collected under this section resulting from a summons issued by a law-enforcement officer employed by the Department of State Police shall be paid into the Literary Fund.

Section 2:- That this ordinance shall be in effect from and after the date of its adoption.
