

ORDINANCE No. 47,289

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND REORDAIN SECTION 2-326.3 OF THE NORFOLK CITY CODE, 1979, AS AMENDED, SO AS TO ELIMINATE THE MEMBERSHIP LIMIT UPON THE NORFOLK CRIMINAL JUSTICE BOARD.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Norfolk:

Section 1:- That Section 2-326.3 of the Norfolk City Code, 1979, as amended is hereby amended and reordained to read in its entirety as follows:

Sec. 2-326.3.

**Creation, composition,
appointment and
compensation of members.**

Pursuant to the provision of title 53.1, article II, of the Code of Virginia, 1950, as amended, and to section 141 of the City of Norfolk Charter, there is hereby created a board to be known as the Norfolk Criminal Justice Board, the members to be appointed by City Council. The board shall, at a minimum, include the following members: a member of the governing body or a city manager, a city executive appointed by the governing body, a general district court judge, a circuit court judge, a juvenile and domestic relations district court judge, the chief magistrate, the chief of police, the sheriff, an attorney for the commonwealth, an attorney who is experienced in the defense of criminal matters, a local educator, an administrator of the community services board, and five (5) citizens from the community.

Section 2:- That this ordinance shall be in effect from and after its date of adoption.
