AN ORDINANCE TO REDUCE THE ASSESSMENT RATIO APPLICABLE TO GENERAL AVIATION AIRCRAFT SUBJECT TO HORRY COUNTY PROPERTY TAX TO A FOUR (4%) PERCENT RATE BASED UPON THE FAIR MARKET VALUE OF THE AIRCRAFT.

WHEREAS, the South Carolina General Assembly, with the approval of the Governor, has amended the South Carolina Code of Law by adding Section 12-43-360; and

WHEREAS, Horry County Council has reviewed, not only the total assessed value of the general aviation aircraft registered in Horry County, but also the total revenue generated at the ten and one-half (10.5%) percent assessment ratio that exists presently, and

WHEREAS, Horry County Council believes that additional revenue will be generated as a result of additional general aviation aircraft being registered in Horry County if there is a reduction in the assessment ratio,

NOW, THEREFORE, by the power and authority granted to the Horry County Council by the Constitution of the State of South Carolina and the powers granted to the County by the General Assembly of the State, it is ordained and enacted that:

1) The **assessment ratio** applicable to general aviation aircraft shall be reduced from a ten and one-half (10.5%) assessment ratio down to a **four (4%) percent** assessment ratio.

2) **Severability**: If a Section, Sub-section, or part of this Ordinance shall be deemed or found to conflict with a provision of South Carolina law, or other pre-emptive legal principle, then that Section, Sub-section, or part of this Ordinance shall be deemed ineffective, but the remaining parts of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

3) **Conflict with Preceding Ordinances**: If a Section, Sub-section or provision of this Ordinance shall conflict with any provisions of a Section, Sub-section or part of a preceding Ordinance of Horry County, then the preceding Section, Sub-section, or part shall be deemed repealed and no longer in effect.

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- 4) **Effective Date:** This Ordinance shall become effective on Third Reading.


