ORDINANCE NO. 2022-040

An Ordinance amending the Code of Ordinances of the City of Pasadena, Texas at Chapter 24, Parks and Recreation, by amending Section 24-13 Fees; providing a repealing clause; providing a savings clause; and providing for severability.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PASADENA:

SECTION 1. That the Code of Ordinances of the City of Pasadena, Texas is hereby amended at Chapter 24, Parks and Recreation, by amending Section 24-13 Fees, to hereafter read as shown on the attached Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2. That all other terms and provisions of such Chapter, except as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. That all ordinances in force when this Ordinance becomes effective which are inconsistent with, or in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby expressly repealed insofar as said ordinances are inconsistent with or are in conflict with this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. That all rights and remedies which have accrued in favor of the City under this Chapter and amendments thereto shall be and are preserved for the benefit of the City.

SECTION 5. That the City Council of the City of Pasadena, Texas does hereby declare that if any Section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase, word or portion of this Ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, the City Council would have passed and ordained any

and all remaining portions of this Ordinance without the inclusion of that portion or portions which may be so found to be unconstitutional or invalid, and declares that its intent is to make no portion of this Ordinance dependent upon the validity of any other portion thereof, and that all said remaining portions shall continue in full force and effect.

SECTION 6. That the City Council officially determines that a sufficient written notice of the date, hour, place and subject of this meeting of the City Council was posted at a place convenient to the public at the City Hall of the City for the time required by law preceding this meeting, as required by the Open Meetings Law, Chapter 551, Texas Government Code; and that this meeting has been open to the public as required by law at all times during which this ordinance and the subject matter thereof has been discussed, considered and formally acted upon. The City Council further confirms such written notice and the contents and posting thereof.
