AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CLASS A-4 SEASONAL TAVERN LIQUOR LICENSE LOCATION DESCRIPTION TO INCLUDE WAUKEGAN HARBOR

WHEREAS, Section 3-10 of the Waukegan City Code of Ordinances (“*Code of Ordinances*”) various classes of liquor licenses available within the City, including the Class A-4 Seasonal Tavern License (“*Class A-4 License*”); and

WHEREAS, the Class A-4 License is intended to provide a time limited permission to sell alcoholic beverages in certain city-owned lakefront locations; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it would be appropriate to amend Section 3-10 of the Code of Ordinances to clarify that Class A-4 Licenses may also be issued to business seeking to operate in the Waukegan Harbor;

NOW THEREFORE, IN EXERCISE OF ITS HOME RULE POWERS, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF WAUKEGAN, ILLINOIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. Section 3-10(1)(f)(iv) of the City of Waukegan, Illinois Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to read as follows: (additions underlined, deletions ~~stricken~~)

iv. Class A-4—Seasonal Tavern License. This license is available only to businesses which have entered into contracts with the city for vending at the Municipal Beach, Stiner Pavilion and other city-owned lakefront properties or to licensees seeking to operate seasonal locations in the Waukegan Harbor. This license authorizes the retail sale of alcoholic liquors by the contracting vendor for consumption in city-designated areas immediately adjoining the vending location. The license is valid only ~~during the term of the vendor's contract with the city, generally May 1 through September 30~~ April 15 through October 15 of any calendar year, or such longer period as may be set forth in the vendor's contract with the City. The fee shall be 5/12ths of the fee charged to Class A licensees generally in section 3-55 of this Code in recognition of the limited duration of this license class and its annual termination on September 30. Additionally, the initial application fee set forth in section 3-55 of this Code shall be waived, however the administrative processing fee and fingerprinting charges in section 3-55 shall apply. Additional regulations relating to service within corrals or other segregated areas, banning of glass containers, and the like may be described within the term of the vendors' contracts and shall be enforceable under this Code.

SECTION TWO. If any provision of this ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance is held to be invalid, then the remainder of the ordinance, including the application of such part or provision to other persons or circumstances, shall not be affected

and shall continue in full force and effect. To this end, the provisions of this ordinance are severable.

SECTION THREE. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.
