

ORDINANCE NUMBER O-07- 05

AN ORDINANCE

To amend subsection 2.05.05, Table 2-1 of Zoning Ordinance of the Code of the City of Douglasville, to add “church as an accessory use”; to amend subsection 3.34.04 of said Ordinance to add libraries and social service centers as customary accessory uses to a church; to amend subsection 3.76. b. of said Ordinance to restrict relocation of non-conforming signs for which the owner has been compensated; to repeal any conflicting ordinances; to provide an effective date; and other purposes.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of Douglasville, Georgia, and it is hereby ordained by the authority thereof as follows:

SECTION ONE

Subsection 2.05.05, Table 2-1 of the Zoning Ordinance of the Code of the City of Douglasville is hereby amended to read as shown in Exhibit A.

SECTION TWO

Subsection 3.34.04 of the Zoning Ordinance of the Code of the City of Douglasville is amended to read as follows:

3.34.04. Customary accessory uses to a church or other place of worship. Each of the following uses is considered to be a customary accessory use to a church or other place of worship and may be situated on the same lot with the principal use to which it serves as an accessory if allowed by section 2.05:

- a. Religious education buildings.
- b. Parish house, meeting or gathering facilities for members.
- c. Parsonage, along with the customary accessory uses to a dwelling.
- d. Cemetery.
- e. Libraries
- f. Social Service Centers

SECTION THREE

Subsection 3.76. b. of Appendix A – Zoning of the Code of the City of Douglasville is amended to read as follows:

- b. Existing signs which were legally erected which have become nonconforming and do not meet the setback requirements of this division due to a road widening project may be moved to meet the setback requirements of this division but shall not be increased in size, shape or changed in any manner except as to meet the requirements of this division; provided however, this subsection shall not allow the relocation of any sign for which the value has been paid to the owner by any government or government agency in conjunction with a road widening project. No sign shall be relocated pursuant to this subsection before such time as the sign owner shall provide to the Zoning Official a signed copy of the purchase contract or condemnation documents showing transfer of the owner's land for road widening.


SECTION FOUR
