

ORDINANCE NUMBER 0-04-01

AN ORDINANCE

To amend section 1-10 of Chapter One - the General Provisions Ordinance of the Code of the City of Douglasville, Georgia, to revise minimum bond amounts for miscellaneous offenses; to enact a revised bond schedule for the Douglasville Municipal Recorder's Court; to repeal any conflicting ordinances; to provide an effective date; and other purposes.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of Douglasville, Georgia, and it is ordained by the authority thereof as follows:

SECTION ONE

Section 1-10 of the General Provisions Ordinance of the Code of the City of Douglasville, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 1-10. Minimum bond requirements for code violations other than Uniform Traffic violations. Code violations of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Douglasville, Georgia, without a state or local bond schedule shall now carry a bond as set below:

- (1) First offense . . . \$75.00
- (2) Second offense . . . \$150.00
- (3) Third and subsequent offense with a mandatory court appearance . . . \$200.00

SECTION TWO

The bond schedule for the Douglasville Municipal Recorder's Court is hereby revised and amended as shown on Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein.

SECTION THREE

This ordinance shall become effective on February 17, 2004.

SECTION FOUR

All ordinances and resolutions and parts of ordinances and resolutions in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.
