

ORDINANCE NO. 1358

**AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE AMENDMENT
TO THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR THE CITY OF
YUKON, OKLAHOMA, PROVIDING FOR THE
DISPOSITION OF DRILLING MUD AND OTHER
DRILLING FLUIDS, PROVIDING FOR VIOLATIONS OF
SAID ORDINANCE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the City of Yukon seeks to provide for the proper disposition of drilling mud and other drilling fluids so as to protect the lands of the City of Yukon and to maintain the general welfare of the citizens of Yukon.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF YUKON, OKLAHOMA: That the Code of Ordinances, City of Yukon, is hereby amended by addition of certain sections to address the disposal of drilling mud and other drilling fluids

Section 1.

The drilling of oil and gas wells produces by-products such as drilling mud other drilling fluids, all which must be properly disposed of.

Section 34-143.

The disposal of drilling mud and other drilling fluids shall be by transporting the mud or other fluids by a licensed, bonded transporter, to a state licensed disposal site. The drilling mud and fluids must not be buried in an earthen pit, pumped down the well bore, or down the annulus of a well, nor spread upon the surface of the grounds.

Violations of this ordinance shall be punished pursuant to Section 1-7 of the Code of Ordinances for the City of Yukon, Oklahoma.

Section 2.



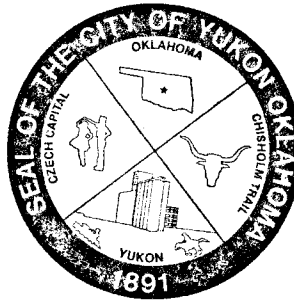

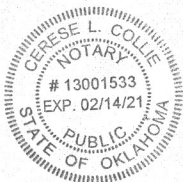
