

ORDINANCE NO. 22-021

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF GALVESTON, TEXAS, AMENDING "THE CODE OF THE CITY OF GALVESTON 1982, AS AMENDED", CHAPTER 34, "TRAFFIC" ARTICLE V. STOPPING, STANDING OR PARKING", DIVISION 1. GENERALLY, SECTION 34-110(a), "SEAWALL RESIDENTIAL PARKING DISTRICT – NO PARKING; EXEMPTION WITH PARKING PERMIT" TO ADD BOTH SIDES OF AVENUE R1/2 FROM 35TH STREET TO 37TH STREET; MAKING VARIOUS FINDINGS AND PROVISIONS RELATED TO THE SUBJECT; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Staff recommends adding both sides of Avenue R1/2 from 35th Street to 37th Street to the residential restricted parking areas in the City of Galveston; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council deems it in the public's interest to amend the Code of The City of Galveston 1982, as amended", Chapter 34, "Traffic" Section 34-110(A) , "Seawall Residential Parking District – No Parking; Exemption With Parking Permit; "to add both sides of Avenue R1/2 from 35th Street to 37th Street, as provided in Section 2 below.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GALVESTON, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. The findings and recitations set out in the preamble to this Ordinance are found to be true and correct and they are hereby adopted by the City Council and made a part hereof for all purposes.

SECTION 2. Chapter 34, "Traffic" of "The Code of The City of Galveston 1982, "Division 1.", "Generally", Section 34-110(a), is amended to read and provide as follows:

DIVISION 1. - GENERALLY

Sec. 34-110a. - Seawall residential parking district—No parking; exemption with parking permit.

- (a) When signs area erected at each block giving notice thereof, no person shall park a vehicle at any time on any day upon the following streets:

(95) East and west side of 59th Street from Maco Drive to approximately four hundred (400) feet north of Seawall Boulevard.

(96) Both sides of Avenue R1/2 from 35th Street to 37th Street.

- (b) The parking prohibitions of this subsection shall not apply to those residents exhibiting residential parking decals, or to guests of residents who display a visitor parking decal or sign, or to police, fire, or other emergency vehicles parking in the area in performance of police, fire, or other emergency functions. Residential parking decals shall be issued by the city manager or his designee. Residential decals shall be nontransferable. It shall be unlawful for

any resident or guest to transfer, give, exchange, or sell any residential decal to another person. All residential decals shall be displayed on the front or rear windshield of the vehicle.

SECTION 3. It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that the sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses and phrases of this Ordinance are severable and, if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this Ordinance should be declared invalid by the final judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs and sections of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. All Ordinances or parts thereof in conflict herewith are repealed to the extent of such conflict only.

SECTION 5. All Ordinances of general and permanent nature, and amendments to such Ordinances, hereinafter adopted by the City Council, shall be drafted, so far as possible, as specific amendments of, or additions to, this Code. Amendments to this Code are intended for publication to the Galveston City Code. The Codifier is authorized pursuant to the Galveston City Code to make non-substantive changes to the Ordinance prior to publishing.

SECTION 6. In accordance with the provisions of Sections 12 and 13 of Article II of the City Charter this Ordinance has been publicly available in the office of the City Secretary for not less than 72 hours prior to its adoption; that this Ordinance may be read and published by descriptive caption only.

SECTION 7. This Ordinance is adopted on April 28, 2022 and shall become effective on, from and after its adoption and publication in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Galveston and upon the posting of applicable signage.
