**WHEREAS:** On the 17th day of September, 2013, the Town Council enacted Resolution 2013-180, encompassing all fees and charges imposed by departments of the Town for the issuance of permits and licenses and the providing of services and copies and otherwise, in a fee schedule attached to said Resolution and incorporated therein by reference, and

**WHEREAS:** Resolution 2013-180 was on the 16<sup>th</sup> of August, 2016 amended by the Town Council through the enactment of Resolution 2016-137, and

**WHEREAS:** Whereas said fee schedule, as from time to time amended, includes all such fees and charges imposed by the departments of the Town, and

**WHEREAS:** The Town Council has determined that it has become necessary that certain fees within said fee schedule require amendment,

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** that the Town Council of the Town of West Warwick hereby amends Resolution 2013-180, as amended by Resolution 2016-137, and the fee schedule, as having from time to time been amended and attached to said Resolution and incorporated therein by reference, as follows:
