

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 70, “OFFENSES AND MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS” OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES

WHEREAS, the City of Rolling Meadows Code of Ordinances do not currently contain a provision to prohibit a trespass; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the City to provide for trespass as an ordinance violation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Rolling Meadows, Illinois:

SECTION ONE: Chapter 70, “Offenses and Miscellaneous Provisions” is hereby amended by adding thereto, the following:

Sec. 70-43 Trespass

Whoever enters upon the land, or building, or any part thereof, after receiving, prior to such entrance, notice from the owner, occupant or duly authorized agent that such entry is forbidden, or remains upon the land or building, of another, after receiving notice from the owner, occupant or duly authorized representative, to depart commits a trespass.

A person has received notice from the owner, occupant or duly authorized representative within the meaning of this section if he has been notified personally, either orally or in writing, including a valid court order, or if a printed or written notice forbidding such entry or remaining on the premises has been conspicuously posted or exhibited at the main entrance of such land, building or portion thereof.

A violation of this section shall be a misdemeanor.

SECTION TWO: Appendix B “Schedule of Rates, Fees, Fines and Penalties” is hereby amended Article XIII, “Offenses” by adding thereto, the following:

R. Except as otherwise specifically provided for in this Code of Ordinances, where any offense is a misdemeanor, the penalty shall be a fine of not less than \$100.00 nor more than \$750.00 and/or a period of imprisonment of not more than six (6) months.

SECTION THREE: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in the manner provided by law.
