

ORDINANCE NO. 2024-17

1 AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD
2 COUNTY, FLORIDA, PERTAINING TO CABLE TV AND OPEN VIDEO SYSTEMS;
3 REPEALING SECTIONS 20-401 THROUGH 20-481 AND SECTIONS 20-501
4 THROUGH 20-544 OF THE BROWARD COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES (“CODE”);
5 AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, INCLUSION IN THE CODE, AND AN
6 EFFECTIVE DATE.

9 WHEREAS, certain provisions of the Broward County Code of Ordinances
10 (“Code”) relating to cable television and open video systems are obsolete; and

11 WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners finds it appropriate to repeal
12 these provisions at this time,

13 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
14 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

15 Section 1. Chapter 20, Article XVII, and Sections 20-401 through 20-481 of the
16 Code, pertaining to Cable TV Regulations, are hereby repealed in their entirety.

17 Section 2. Chapter 20, Article XVIII, and Sections 20-501 through 20-544 of the
18 Code, pertaining to Open Video Systems, are hereby repealed in their entirety.

19 Section 3. Severability.

20 If any portion of this Ordinance is determined by any court to be invalid, the invalid
21 portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the remainder of this
22

23 Ordinance. If any court determines that this Ordinance, in whole or in part, cannot be
24 legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such
25 determination will not affect the applicability of this Ordinance to any other individual,
26 group, entity, property, or circumstance.

27 Section 4. Inclusion in the Broward County Code of Ordinances.

28 It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners that the provisions of this
29 Ordinance become part of the Broward County Code of Ordinances as of the effective
30 date. The sections of this Ordinance may be renumbered or relettered and the word “
31 ordinance” may be changed to “section,” “article,” or such other appropriate word or
32 phrase to the extent necessary to accomplish such intention.

33 Section 5. Effective Date.

34 This Ordinance is effective as of the date provided by law.
