AN ORDINANCE OF THE BROWNSVILLE CITY COMMISSION, AMENDING THE UNIFIED DEVELOPMENT CODE (UDC), ARTICLE 3 – SUBDIVISION REGULATIONS, SECTION 3.4.4 SIDEWALKS, TABLE 3.4-1: SIDEWALK AND BICYCLE FACILITIES, TO REPLACE ALL REFERENCES MADE TO THE 2013 BICYCLE AND TRAIL MASTER PLAN TO THE BICYCLE AND TRAIL MASTER PLAN; AND DEALING WITH RELATED MATTERS.

WHEREAS, the Bicycle and Trail Master Plan guides the existing and future development of sidewalks, trails, and bicycle infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, this Master Plan focuses on the analysis and planning strategy for sidewalks in the City of Brownsville; and

WHEREAS, pedestrian facility specifications and alignments are outlined in the Bicycle and Trail Master Plan; and

WHEREAS, this amendment will establish accurate reference to the adopted version of the Bicycle and Trail Master Plan within the Unified Development Code (UDC).

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF BROWNSVILLE THAT THE CODE OF ORDINANCES IS HEREBY AMENDED, REPLACING REFERENCES MADE TO THE 2013 BICYCLE AND TRAIL MASTER PLAN WITHIN TABLE 3.4-1: SIDEWALK AND BICYCLE FACILITIES TO THE BICYCLE AND TRAIL MASTER PLAN.

IT IS ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF BROWNSVILLE THAT IN THE EVENT OF ANY CONFLICTS BETWEEN THIS NEWLY ADOPTED UNIFIED DEVELOPMENT CODE AND OTHER ORDINANCES INVOLVING THE SAME SUBJECTMATTER, THIS UNIFIED DEVELOPMENT CODE SHALL GOVERN.

IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED THAT THE CODE OF ORDINANCES IS HEREIN AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

Facility	Description	Minimum Width (FT)
Sidewalks	Standard City sidewalks adjacent to the roadway intended to be used by pedestrians.	5
Multi-Use Pathways	Multi-use pathways are sidewalks that are adjacent to a roadway intended to be used by pedestrians and cyclists.	12
Trails	Trails are off-street sidewalks that are completely separated from roads and are typically placed within greenbelt corridors or parks.	10
