

ORDINANCE NO. (2021) 189

AN ORDINANCE TO EXPAND HOURS OF OPERATION FOR FOOD TRUCKS IN DESIGNATED ON-STREET PARKING SPACES

WHEREAS, the City of Raleigh Code of Ordinances contains regulations associated with the operation of food trucks on private property and certain portions of right-of-way within the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to expand the hours of operation for when a food truck may operate within parking spaces within right-of-way that have been designated for food truck parking and operation.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RALEIGH THAT:

Section 1. Section 12-1024.1(c)(7) of the City of Raleigh Code of Ordinances (the “City Code”) is amended as follows, with underlined language added and strikethrough language deleted:

Once a permit has been granted by the *City*, a *food truck* may operate within the *permitted parking space* on every day of the week from the hours of 10:00 a.m. to ~~3:00~~ 10:00 p.m. ~~During the First Friday Festival of each month, the food truck may operate until 8:00 p.m.~~ The *food truck* may not operate or park within the *permitted parking space* before 10:00 a.m. and must cease operation and leave the *permitted parking space* by ~~3:00~~ 10:00 p.m., ~~except during the First Friday Festival.~~ **Permitted hours for operation for any specific parking space shall be listed in the applicable traffic schedule, as adopted by the Council.**

Section 2. The following shall be deleted from Traffic Schedule 13 (No Parking Zones): North Street, north side, food truck vendor parking, 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. all days and 10:00a.m. to 8:00 p.m. first Fridays, beginning at a point 25 feet west of Harrington Street, westward 60 feet.

Section 3. The following shall be added to Traffic Schedule 13 (No Parking Zones): North Street, north side, food truck vendor parking, 10:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m., Monday to Sunday, beginning at a point 25 feet west of Harrington Street, westward 60 feet.

Section 4. Nothing within this ordinance is intended to allow a food truck to remain within a *permitted parking space* outside of the operating hours described in Section 12-1024.1(c)(7) of the City Code. Vehicles parked within a food truck zone in violation of the City Code shall be subject to enforcement per the City Code and applicable North Carolina law.
