ORDINANCE 642-A-2022

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF UNIVERSAL CITY TO REPEAL ORDINANCE 279-A-1977 AND 279-B-1981, CHAPTER 1-3 COMMISSIONS, BOARDS, COMMITTEES AND AUTHORITIES, ARTICLE XIII. MUNICIPAL DISASTER EMERGENCY SERVICES COMMITTEE (CODIFIED as 1-3-80 thru 1-3-90) AND TO AMEND THE UNIVERSAL CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES ACCORDINGLY; AND SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Universal City, Texas is a home-rule municipality located in Bexar County, Texas and duly established under the Texas Constitution and the laws of this State; and

WHEREAS, the City Council established a Municipal Disaster Emergency Services Committee of Universal City on 19 July 1977 by Ordinance 279-A and on 02 June 1981 by Ordinance 279-B; and

WHEREAS, The City Council on 03 May 2016 voted and approved to establish an Emergency Management Program that provides for the same powers and duties as the Municipal Disaster Emergency Services Committee, but did not formally repeal the Municipal Disaster Emergency Services Committee from the City's Code of Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, The City Council has determined that is prudent to formally repeal the Municipal Disaster Emergency Services Committee and remove it from the City's Code of Ordinances.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDIANED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSAL CITY, TEXAS THAT:

SECTION 1.

ARTICLE XIII. *MUNICIPAL DISASTER EMERGENCY SERVICES COMMITTEE* (CODIFIED as 1-3-80 thru 1-3-90) IS REPEALED IN ITS ENTIRETY.

SECTION 2.

THAT all other ordinances, or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent that they are in conflict.

SECTION 3.

THAT this Ordinance shall be construed and enforced in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas and the United State of America.

SECTION 4.

THAT if any provisions of this Ordinance shall be held void or unconstitutional, it is hereby provided that all other parts of the same which are not held void or unconstitutional shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 5.

THAT it is officially found, determined, and declared that the meeting at which this Ordinance is adopted was open to the public in compliance with the advisory issued by the Office of the Governor and public notice of the time, place, and subject matter of the public business to be considered at such meeting, including this Resolution, was given all as required by the Texas Government Code, Chapter 551, as amended.

SECTION 6.

THIS Ordinance will take effect upon its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
