

ORDINANCE # 2986

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 11 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF ARDMORE TITLED "GARBAGE AND REFUSE", MORE SPECIFICALLY AMENDING SECTION 11-11, COLLECTION RATES AND CHARGES AND SECTION 11-21, OPERATION PRIDE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Ardmore, Oklahoma, a Municipal Corporation, as follows:

SECTION I: That Section 11-11 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Ardmore, Oklahoma, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 11-11. Collection rates and charges.

Each customer served by the sanitation department with garbage pickup service shall pay a regular charge for each month or a part thereof for such service, which charge shall be determined as follows:

A. Residential monthly charges (per each polycart):

- (1) One-family residence \$12.03
- (2) Duplexes, apartment complexes, mobile home parks,
and other multiple-dwelling complexes with individual
unit pickup service each month \$12.03

B. Business and commercial charges:

- (1) Monthly charges for business and commercial charges, and apartment complexes, mobile home parks and other multiple-swelling complexes without individual dwelling until services shall be determined as follows:

Containers, 90-gallon polycart, once per week
service (minimum charge) \$20.66

Commercial hand pick-up service, downtown only,
Once per week service (minimum charge) \$20.66

Dumpster Service (per cubic yard collected): Rate effective **July 1, 2016** for dumpsters is \$3.55 per cubic yard. The monthly charge is to be established by the following formula:

of dumpsters x size of dumpster x collection frequency per week x rate x 52 weeks ÷ 12 months = monthly charge

(Example: 2 dumpsters x 6 cubic yards x 3 collections per week x \$3.35 per yard x 52 weeks ÷ 12 months = \$553.80)

Section 11-11.1 Review date for rate schedule.

The rate schedule in section 11-11 shall become effective on **July 1, 2016**. All rates in section 11-11 will increase on each July 1 thereafter by the percent of the consumer price index (CPI) established for the immediately preceding calendar year.

SECTION II: That Section 11-21 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Ardmore, Oklahoma, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 11-21 Operation Pride.

The city operates an Operation Pride bulky waste collection program for residential dwellings on city water service and within the city limits. A three dollar and forty-eight cent (\$3.48) charge per residence for this service will be added to the water bill. The city will collect and dispose of bulky waste from residential dwellings that is placed in an accessible open area within ten (10) feet of the public street or road. No pick up will be made if any vehicle is parked in the street obstructing the debris. Pick up is scheduled for approximately every eight (8) weeks. Items are to be placed at the curbside no earlier (or later) than the weekend just before the scheduled week of collection. This schedule is subject to change due to demand, but items must be at the curb/roadside by 7:00 a.m. to ensure pick-up.

Section 11-21.1 Items allowed for pick-up.

Section 11-21.2 Items no allowed for pick-up.

No change.

Section 11-21.3 Instructions for curbside pick-up under operation pride.

No change.

Section 11-21.4 Review date for rate schedule.

The rate schedule in section 11-21 shall become effective on July 1, 2016. All rates in section 11-21 will increase on each July 1 thereafter by the percent of the consumer price index (CPI) established for the immediately preceding calendar year.

SECTION III: SEVERABILITY


