

ORDINANCE NUMBER 22-21

An ordinance to amend Section 26-46 of the Beatrice City Code, regarding the disconnection of utilities for nonpayment; to repeal all other conflicting ordinances or parts of ordinances; and to provide for publication in electronic form and for an effective date of this ordinance.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEATRICE, NEBRASKA:

SECTION 1. That Section 26-46 of the Beatrice City Code be and hereby is amended as follows:

"Sec. 26-46. – Disconnection for nonpayment.

If bills for utility become delinquent, the board of public works shall have the right to disconnect and discontinue all utility services furnished by the board of public works to the consumer so in arrears at all locations in their name. Disconnection shall be set for not less than seven (7) business days after the date upon which the bill became delinquent."

SECTION 2. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.


SECTION 3. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in electronic form as provided by law.
