

EMERGENCY ORDINANCE No. 2020/06

EXTENDING THE EFFECT OF EMERGENCY ORDINANCE 2020-03 REGARDING THE REQUIREMENT THAT INDIVIDUALS WEAR FACE COVERINGS IN CERTAIN CURCUMSTANCES AND LOCATIONS IN THE LIMITS OF THE COUNTY OF BEAUFORT, SOUTH CAROLINA, AND PROVIDING FOR SERAVBILITY EXCEPTIONS AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, Beaufort County Council enacted Emergency Ordinance 2020-03, effective July 3, 2020, requiring the wearing of cloth or other types of face coverings in certain circumstances; and

WHEREAS, circumstances still exist which call for continued wearing of masks, and such conditions will exist into the foreseeable future;


NOW THEREFORE, BEAUFORT COUNTY COUNCIL HEREBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

County Council finds that all conditions and recommendations which existed at the time of adoption of Emergency Ordinance 2020-03 continue to exist, and will continue for the foreseeable future; and Council also finds that in order to protect, preserve, and promote the general health, safety, welfare, and the peace and order of the community, the County has, and will continue, to take steps to try and protect the citizens, employers, and employees within the County from an increased risk of exposure to and transmission of COVID-19 and;

IT IS ORDERED that Emergency Ordinance 2020-03 is hereby extended until October 23, 2020. All remaining terms of Emergency Ordinance 2020-03 shall remain in full force and effect.

MOVED, APPROVED, AND ADOPTED AS AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE THIS 24TH DAY OF AUGUST 2020.
