On motion of Supervisor Sharp, which carried by a vote of 5-0, the following was adopted:

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 6 “ELECTIONS”, ARTICLE III “PRECINCTS AND POLLING PLACES”;
SPECIFICALLY, TO CHANGE A PRECINCT POLLING PLACE IN ELECTION DISTRICT 4**

WHEREAS, the County of Bedford passed an Ordinance on the 25th day of March 2013 as to election districts, precincts and polling places; and

WHEREAS, Precinct 404 St Paul Baptist Church is undergoing renovations which will not be suitable as the use of a polling place in Election District 4; and

WHEREAS, the Registrar recommends that the polling place be relocated to the Forest Recreation Center located at 1088 Rustic Village Road, Forest, VA 24551; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Bedford as follows:

ARTICLE III. PRECINCTS AND POLLING PLACES

DIVISION I. GENERALLY

Sec. 6-36. Established.

The election precincts shall be named according to the polling place location, as follows:

ELECTION DISTRICT NO. 4

Precinct/Polling Place

401 Forest Elementary School

402 Thomas Jefferson Elementary School

403 Knights of Columbus Building

404 ~~St. Paul Baptist Church~~ **Forest Recreation Center**

Sec. 6-46. - District No. 4 precincts.

The boundaries of the precincts in Election District No. 4 shall be as follows:

(1) Forest Elementary School:

Beginning at a point where US 221 (Forest Rd.) crosses Elk Creek; then northwest along Elk Creek to Route 644 (Old Cifax Rd.); then east on Route 644 (Old Cifax Rd./Coffee Rd.) to Route 663 (Perrowville Rd.); then south on Route 663 (Perrowville Rd.) to the intersection of the American Electric Power Company Lynchburg-Roanoke (East-West) Transmission line; then northeast along the transmission line to a point where the transmission line meets Ivy Creek; then south along Ivy Creek, continuing along Ivy Creek and then Ivy Lake to a point where Ivy Lake meets (generally) the end of Haines Point Ter.; then north along Haines Point Ter. to Eastwind Dr.; then continuing along Eastwind Dr. to the intersection of Ivy Lake Dr.; then south and southwest along Ivy Lake Dr. to a point where Ivy Lake Dr. intersects with Ivy Creek; then east along Ivy Creek to Route 1232 (Whistling Swan Drive); then south on Route 1232 (Whistling Swan Drive) to Route 1231 (MacLaren Place); then southeast on Route 1231 (MacLaren Place) to Route 1240 (Lake Vista Drive); then south on Route 1240 (Lake Vista Drive) to Route 1239 (Spring Lake Road); then northwest on Route 1239 (Spring Lake Road) to Route 609 (Gum Tree Road); then southwest along Route 609 (Gum Tree Road) to Route 221 (Forest Road); then west along Route 221 to its intersection with Elk Creek, the point of beginning.

(2) Thomas Jefferson Elementary School:

Beginning at a point where the Norfolk Southern Railroad intersects Elk Creek; then northeast along Elk Creek to US 221 (Forest Road); then east on US 221 (Forest Road) to Route 661 (Bateman Bridge Road); then south on Route 661 (Bateman Bridge Road) to Route 1573 (Ramblewood Road); then south on Route 1573 (Ramblewood Road) to the boundary between Bedford County and Campbell County; then south along the Bedford/Campbell County line to Route 622 (Waterlick Road); then northwest along Route 622 (Waterlick Road) to Route 811 (Thomas Jefferson Road); then north along Route 811 (Thomas Jefferson Road) to where it intersects the Norfolk Southern Railroad; then west on the Norfolk Southern Railroad to its intersection with Elk Creek, the point of beginning.

(3) Knights of Columbus Building:

Beginning at a point in the Bedford-Campbell County line at Route 1573 (Ramblewood Road); then northwest on Route 1573 (Ramblewood Road) to Route 661 (Bateman Bridge Road); then northeast on Route 661 (Bateman Bridge Road) to Route 221 (Forest Road); then west along Route 221 (Forest Road) to Route 609 (Gumtree Road) then north on Route 609 (Gumtree Road) to Route 1239 (Spring Lake Road); then east on Route 1239 (Spring Lake Road) to Route 1240 (Lake Vista Drive); then north on Route 1240 (Lake Vista Drive) to Route 1231 (MacLaren Place); then northwest on Route 1231 (MacLaren Place) to Route 1232 (Whistling Swan Drive); then north on Route 1232 (Whistling Swan Drive) to Ivy Creek; then north on Ivy Creek to Route 621 (Cottontown Road); then east on Route 621 (Cottontown Road) to the Norfolk Southern spur line; then northeast with the spur line to the Lynchburg City limits; then southeast with the Lynchburg

City limits to the Bedford-Campbell County line; then south with the County line to the point of beginning.

(4) ~~St. Paul Church:~~ **Forest Recreation Center:**

Beginning at a point where Route 622 (Everett Road) crosses Elk Creek; then northeast along Elk Creek to the Norfolk Southern Railroad; then east on the Norfolk Southern Railroad to Route 811 (Thomas Jefferson Rd.); then south and southwest on Route 811 (Thomas Jefferson Rd.) to a point where it meets an unnamed jeep trail, approximately .15 miles northeast of Route 704 (Great Oak Road); then northwest along the jeep trail to the vicinity of St. Paul's Church; then northwest along St. Paul's Church Circle to Route 622 (Everett Road); then west on Route 622 (Everett Road) to the intersection with Elk Creek, the point of beginning.
