ORDINANCE NO. 16-27

AN ORDINANCE OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING SECTION 2-22-9 OF THE MANATEE COUNTY CODE RELATING TO DESIGNATION OF CERTAIN ROADS PERMITTING THE OPERATION OF GOLF **CARTS: PROVIDING FOR DEFINITIONS:** AMENDING REQUIREMENTS FOR POSTING SIGNS; INCORPORATING **PROVISIONS** OF **FLORIDA** STATUTES RELATING TO GOLF CART OPERATION AND EQUIPMENT; PROVIDING FOR ENFORCEMENT **PUNISHMENT PURSUANT** AND TO **FLORIDA CART STATUTES: CREATING GOLF** ROAD DESIGNATIONS WITHIN HEATHER HILLS ESTATES AND THE VILLAGE OF CORTEZ; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

- **WHEREAS**, Section 316.212, Florida Statutes, provides for the operation of golf carts upon public roads and streets under certain circumstances; and
- **WHEREAS**, Subsection 316.212(1), Florida Statutes, provides that golf carts may be operated upon a county road or street that has been designated by a county for use by golf carts; and
- **WHEREAS**, Subsection 316.212(1), Florida Statutes, provides that, prior to designating a county road or street for use by golf carts, the County must first determine that golf carts may safely travel on or cross the public road or street, considering factors including the speed, volume, and character of motor vehicle traffic using the road or street; and
- **WHEREAS**, Subsection 316.212(1), Florida Statutes, provides that, upon a determination that golf carts may be safely operated on a designated road or street, the County must post appropriate signs to indicate that such operation is allowed; and
- **WHEREAS**, Manatee County Resolution No. 14-52 sets forth the procedures and criteria relating to the designation of public rights-of-way for the operation of golf carts; and
- **WHEREAS**, County staff received a request from residents within Heather Hills Estates, in accordance with Manatee County Resolution No. 14-52, requesting that the Board of County Commissioners approve an ordinance designating certain roads and streets within Heather Hills Estates as golf cart roads; and
- WHEREAS, County staff have reviewed the request, evaluated the public roads and streets and considered factors including the speed, volume, and character of motor vehicles using the public roads and streets within Heather Hills Estates, and determined that the operation of

golf carts may safely travel on or cross certain public roads and streets within Heather Hills Estates; and

WHEREAS, County staff have recommended revisions to the public roads and streets approved for the operation of golf carts by adding certain roads and streets within Heather Hills Estates to the golf cart roads designated in Section 2-22-9 of the Manatee County Code; and

WHEREAS, based on the recommendations of County staff and considering factors including the speed, volume, and character of motor vehicle traffic using the roads and streets, the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County hereby determines that golf carts may safely travel on the public roads and streets within Heather Hills Estates subdivision designated in this Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County finds and determines that it is in the best interest of the County and the residents of the County to revise the public roads and streets approved for the operation of golf carts by adding certain roads and streets in the Heather Hills Estates subdivision and to amend the golf cart roads designated in Section 2-22-9 of the Manatee County Code; and

WHEREAS, County staff received a request from residents in the Village of Cortez, in accordance with Manatee County Resolution No. 14-52, requesting that the Board of County Commissioners approve an ordinance designating certain roads and streets in the Village of Cortez as golf cart roads; and

WHEREAS, County staff have reviewed the request, evaluated the public roads and streets and considered factors including the speed, volume, and character of motor vehicles using the public roads and streets within the Village of Cortez, and determined that the operation of golf carts may safely travel on or cross certain public roads and streets within the Village of Cortez; and

WHEREAS, County staff have recommended revisions to the public roads and streets approved for the operation of golf carts by adding certain roads and streets within the Village of Cortez to the golf cart roads designated in Section 2-22-9 of the Manatee County Code; and

WHEREAS, based on the recommendations of County staff and considering factors including the speed, volume, and character of motor vehicle traffic using the roads and streets, the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County hereby determines that golf carts may safely travel on the public roads and streets in the Village of Cortez designated in this ordinance amending Section 2-22-9 of the Manatee County Code; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County finds and determines that it is in the best interest of the County and the residents of the County to revise the public roads and streets approved for the operation of golf carts by adding certain roads and streets within the Village of Cortez and to amend the golf cart roads designated in Section 2-22-9 of the Manatee County Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

- <u>Section 1</u>. Section 2-22-9 of the Manatee County Code is hereby amended to effect textual changes and to add certain approved roadways within the Heather Hills and Village of Cortez communities, as follows:
- Sec. 2-22-9. Designation of certain roads permitting the operation of golf carts.
- (a) The definitions of the applicable words and terms set forth in sections 316.003 and 320.01, Florida Statutes, as amended, shall apply to this section.
- (\underline{ba}) The operation of a golf cart upon specified roads and streets of this county is permitted and golf carts may be operated upon those county roads and streets within the unincorporated area of Manatee County, Florida the county, set forth in paragraph subsection $(\underline{gf})(1)$ of this section.
- (\underline{cb}) The operation of a golf cart is permitted and golf cart crossing areas shall be established across those county roads and streets located within the unincorporated area of Manatee County, Florida the county, set forth in paragraph subsection (gf)(2) of this section.
- (de) The county administrator Public Works Department of Manatee County shall cause to be posted appropriate signs on the roads and streets and at the crossings listed shown in paragraph subsection (gf) of this section to indicate warn motorists that the operation of a golf carts is allowed.
- (ed) A The operation of golf carts as provided by subsections (b) and (c) of this section must comply with all of the requirements set forth in section 316.212, Florida Statutes, may only be operated as amended. provided by subsections (a) and (b) of this section A golf cart may be operated only:
 - (1) During the hours between sunrise and sunset, unless the golf cart is equipped with headlights, brake lights, turn signals, and a windshield;
 - (2) Within one mile of a bona fide golf course By a person who is not under the age of 14;
 - (3) If the golf cart it has been equipped with efficient brakes, reliable steering apparatus, safe tires, a rearview mirror, and red reflectorized warning devices in both front and rear; and
 - (4) <u>If The</u> warning signs required under subsection (c) by paragraph (d) of this section have been posted and remain posted.÷
- (f) <u>Pursuant to subsection 316.212(9), Florida Statutes, violations</u> The provisions of this subsection (d) may be enforced are punishable as provided in chapter F.S. Ch. 316 and 318, Florida Statutes, as amended, violations subject to the penalties provided therein.
- (e) Nothing herein shall be deemed to permit the operation of golf carts in any manner not consistent with F.S. § 316.212, and any other applicable provisions of Florida law, including, but not limited to, rules and regulations establishing equipment that must be

maintained on the golf cart or the hours during which a golf cart may be operated on roads or streets.

- (gf) Golf cart road designations and golf cart crossing areas.
- (1) Golf cart road and street designations. Roads and streets within the following developments and districts:
 - a. through f.: no change

g. Heather Hills Estates:

1st Street West	From 48th Avenue West to 50th Avenue Terrace West
2nd Street West	From 49th Avenue Drive West to 50th Avenue West
3rd Street West	From 48th Avenue West to 49th Avenue West
3rd Street West	From 49th Avenue Drive West to 50th Avenue West
4th Street West	From 48th Avenue Drive West to 50th Avenue Terrace West
48th Avenue West	From 1st Street West to 3rd Street West
48th Avenue Drive West	From 1st Street West to 5th Street West
48th Avenue Terrace West	From 1st Street West to 3rd Street West
49th Avenue West	From 1st Street West to 4th Street West
49th Avenue Drive West	From 1st Street West to 4th Street West

Section 2. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, provision or word of this Ordinance is held invalid, same shall be severable and the remainder of this Ordinance shall not be affected by such invalidity, such that any remainder of the Ordinance shall withstand any severed provision, as the Board of County Commissioners would have adopted the Ordinance and its regulatory scheme even absent the invalid part.

Pursuant to Section 125.68(1), Florida Statutes, the Codifier shall codify the substantive amendments to the Manatee County Code contained in Section 1 of this Ordinance as provided therein, and shall not codify any other sections not designated for codification.
