

Ordinance No. 3892

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF VILLA PARK, DUPAGE COUNTY,  
ILLINOIS AMENDING THE NO PARKING ZONE  
ON THE NORTH AVENUE FRONTAGE ROAD**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Villa Park (the “*Village*”) is a duly organized and validly existing non home-rule municipality created in accordance with the Constitution of the State of Illinois of 1970 and the laws of the State; and,

**WHEREAS**, Section 11-208 of the Illinois Municipal Code (625 ILCS 5/11-208) authorizes municipalities to regulate the standing or parking of vehicles with respect to streets under their jurisdiction; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Village desires to amend the no parking regulations on the North Avenue frontage road.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Villa Park, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

**Section 1:** That the no parking zones in Subsection 14-207(c) of the Villa Park Municipal Code, as amended, be and is hereby amended by deleting the following:

“*Frontage road* (being that road immediately south of and running parallel with North Avenue), south side, from Joyce Avenue to Kramer Avenue between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. except on Saturdays, Sundays and legal holidays.”

**Section 2:** That the no parking zones in Subsection 14-207(c) of the Villa Park Municipal Code, as amended, be and is hereby amended by adding the following:

“*North Avenue frontage road*, immediately south of and parallel with North Avenue – Illinois Route 64, on the south side, from North Kramer Avenue west to the North Avenue – Illinois Route 64 right-of-way.”

**Section 3:** That Section 14-225 be and is hereby added to the Villa Park Municipal Code to read as follows:

“Sec. 14-225. - Permit parking – north side of North Avenue frontage road.

(a) No person shall park a motor vehicle on the north side of the North Avenue frontage road from North Kramer Avenue west to the North Avenue – Illinois Route 64 right-of-way without a valid village permit issued and displayed in accordance with this Section.

(b) Monthly fee permits.

(1) Permits for display on vehicles using the parking described in (a) above may be obtained by submitting a written application to the Village Police Department, 40 South Ardmore, Villa Park, Illinois 60181, accompanied by the monthly permit fee. Permits shall be sold on a monthly basis beginning 30 days before the beginning of the next month, for one space per address of an adjacent home with addresses from \_\_\_\_ North Avenue to \_\_\_\_ North Avenue on a first come first

serve basis. The fee shall be twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) per month irrespective of any fraction of a month remaining at the time of purchase. Each person requesting a permit shall provide all information as may be necessary to assure compliance with the provisions of this section, including vehicle license plate number for the vehicle that will be authorized to use the permit. The permit shall be issued only for the particular vehicle for which a vehicle license plate number is listed on the application and shall be valid only if affixed and displayed on such vehicle, unless transfer to a different vehicle is authorized by the Police Department. Such authorization to transfer shall be valid only if in writing.

(2) Parking permits are to be affixed to the top edge of the rear window, equal distance from each side (center). In the case of a vehicle with a rear window of material other than glass, or without a rear window (i.e., panel trucks, vans, etc.) the permit may be affixed to the lower right side of the front window (passenger side). Should instances arise that are not specifically addressed in this section regarding location of permits, the Police Chief may issue such regulations regarding display of permits as are consistent with the provisions and intent of this section, and shall notify purchasers of permits of such regulations. The permit shall at all times be clearly displayed. In the event the permit is affixed and displayed on a vehicle other than either a vehicle for which the permit was issued or on a vehicle for which a transfer was not authorized in writing, the permit shall be void, not valid for the remainder of the month and the fee paid for the permit shall be forfeited.

(3) It shall be unlawful to park any vehicle without a permit, with an invalid or void permit or not in a properly designated parking stall. Such a violation shall be subject to the penalties set forth in Section 14-220, in addition to the fee forfeiture provided above.”

**Section 4:** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect on Monday January 4, 2016, upon its passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.
