

Ordinance No. 3952

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF VILLA PARK, DUPAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, ADOPTING BY REFERENCE THE ILLINOIS PLUMBING CODE PUBLISHED BY THE ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH INCLUDING WATERSENSE REQUIREMENTS

WHEREAS, the Village of Villa Park (the “Village”) is a duly organized and validly existing non home-rule municipality created in accordance with the Constitution of the State of Illinois of 1970 and the laws of the State; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5/1-3-2 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/1-3-2) the Village may adopt by reference compilations of rules and regulations for the construction, alteration and maintenance of all property, buildings and structures in the Village; and,

WHEREAS, three copies of the code to be adopted were filed in the office of the Village Clerk and kept available for public use, inspection and examination for a period of 30 days before the adoption of this ordinance; and,

WHEREAS, the Village pursuant to Section 55 of the Illinois Building Commission Act (20 ILCS 3918/55) has given notice of the intended adoption of these codes to the Division of Building Codes and Regulations of the Capital Development Board more than 30 days before the adoption of this ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Villa Park, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1: That Sections 7-501, 7-502 and 7-503 of Article 5, Plumbing Code, of Chapter 7 of the Villa Park Municipal Code, as amended, be and is hereby amended to read as follows:

“Sec. 7-501 – Adoption of Plumbing Code

The Illinois Plumbing Code, as amended and published by the Illinois Department of Public Health (77 Ill. Adm. Code 890), is adopted and incorporated by reference as the rules and regulations governing the design and installation of new plumbing or plumbing systems and the alteration of plumbing systems including new construction and any remodeling or renovation that alters, renovates or replaces existing plumbing or plumbing systems except as hereinafter amended.

Sec. 7-502 – Amendments

- A. WaterSense Requirements. Pursuant to 17 Ill. Admin. Code 3730.307(c)(4) and subject to the Illinois Plumbing Code (77 Ill. Admin. Code 890) and the Lawn Irrigation Contractor and Lawn Sprinkler System Registration Code (77 Ill. Admin. Code 892) all new plumbing fixtures and irrigation controllers installed after June 27, 2016 shall bear the WaterSense label (as designated by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency WaterSense Program) when such labeled fixtures are available.

Sec. 7-503 – Enforcement

This Article shall be enforced by the Village’s Plumbing Inspector.”

Section 2: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.


