Kotowski, City Clerk of the City of St. Clair Shores do hereby certify that the attached is a true copy of the Canvass of Votes of the State General Election held on November 3, 2020 as canvassed by the Board of Canvassers of Macomb County Michigan which is on file in the City of St. Clair Shores Office of the City Clerk as of this 1st day of December 2020, on the following ballot proposal enacting this Charter Language as follows:

This is a charter amendment to require a period of public comment of at least two (2) minutes per person at regularly scheduled City Council meetings prior to City Council voting on matters requiring a vote at such meeting, and to require a second period of public comment near the conclusion of each regularly scheduled City Council meeting in conformity with the Michigan Open Meetings Act, as amended.

Ballot Proposal Language:

Shall the Charter of the City of St. Clair Shores be amended to require a period of public comment of at least two (2) minutes per person prior to City Council voting on matters requiring a vote at such meeting, and a second period of public comment near the conclusion of each City Council meeting in conformity with the Michigan Open Meetings Act, as amended?

The Charter language will read as follows:

10.047 Sec. 3.7 (a) Council meetings;quorum; vote required, public comment.

At each regularly scheduled City Council meeting there shall be set aside a period of public comment of at least two (2) minutes per person prior to City Council voting on matters requiring a vote at such meeting, and there shall be set aside a second period of public comment near the conclusion of each regularly scheduled City Council meeting in conformity with the Michigan Open Meetings Act, as amended.
