

COUNCIL BILL NO. 2015- 030

AN ORDINANCE

AMENDING TABLE-VIII-A-MAP OF ARTICLE VIII OF CHAPTER 37 OF THE  
CHAMPAIGN MUNICIPAL CODE, 1985, AS AMENDED  
(ZONING - SIGNS - TABLE VIII-A-MAP)

WHEREAS, the Zoning Ordinance text amendment set forth in this Council Bill was the subject of a public hearing before the Plan Commission as Case PL15-0001 on February 18, 2015; and

WHEREAS, a notice of public hearing before the Plan Commission on February 18, 2015 was published in the Champaign News Gazette on February 1, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission voted unanimously to recommend approval of said amendment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHAMPAIGN, ILLINOIS, as follows:

**Section 1.** That Table VIII-A-MAP of Article VIII of Chapter 37 of the Champaign Municipal Code, 1985, as amended, entitled “OASS Overlay Map”, is hereby amended to read as shown on the attached sheet.

**Section 2.** That this Ordinance shall become effective ten (10) days following publication of this Council Bill.

**Section 3.** That the City Clerk is hereby directed to publish this Ordinance so that its effective date is March 17, 2015.

**Section 4.** If any section, paragraph, or provision of this Ordinance is held to be invalid or unenforceable, such invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance, or the provisions of the Code.

**Section 5.** The provisions of this Ordinance shall take precedence and be interpreted as superseding any other ordinance or statute in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance.

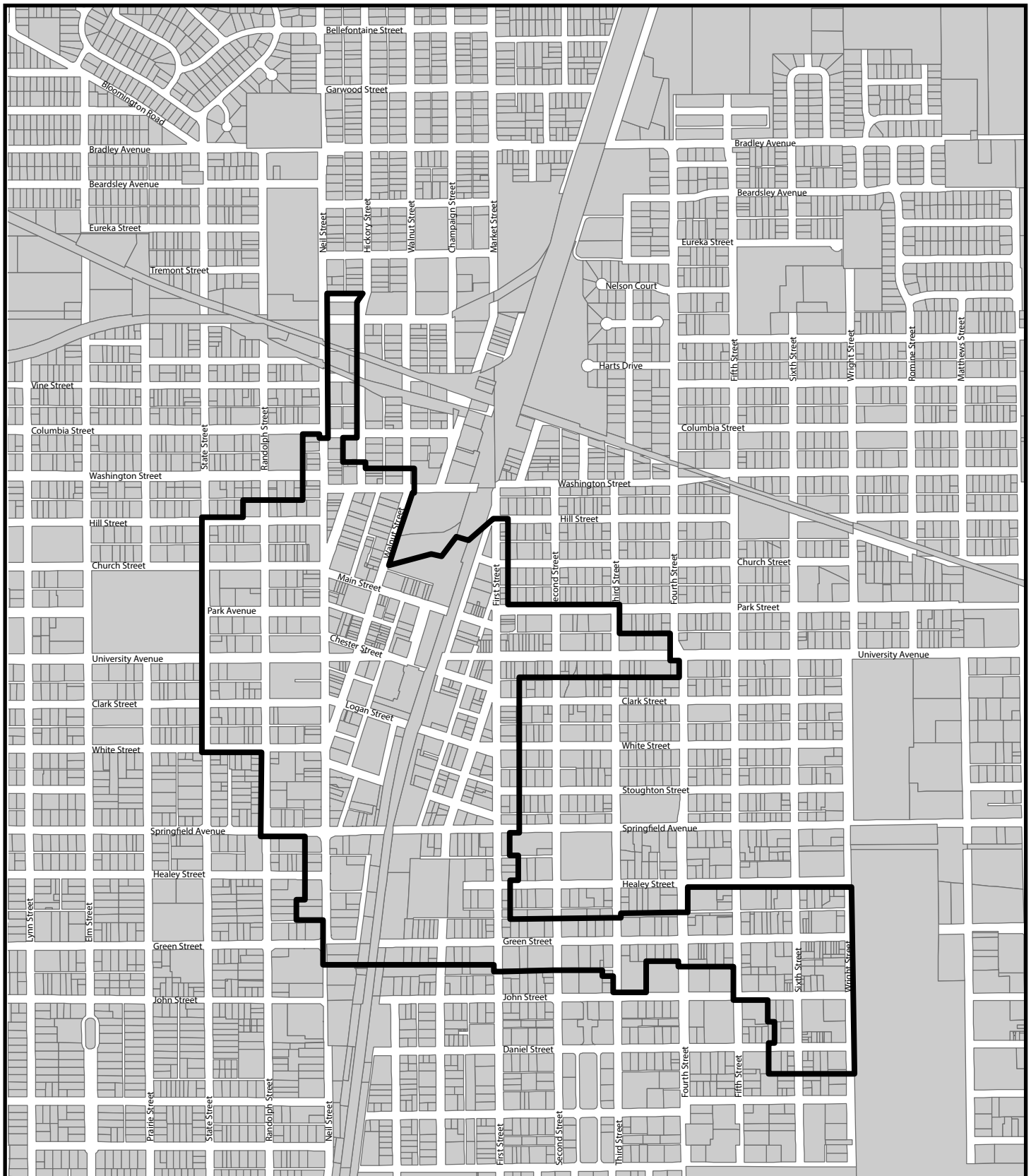

## OASS Overlay Map

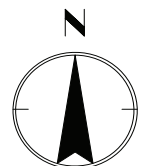


### Legend
