ORDINANCE 1517

AN ORDINANCE BY THE CITY OF COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS INCORPORATING BY REFERENCE THE "STANDARD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE FOR KANSAS CITIES, 51ST EDITION" FOR 2024; PROVIDING CERTAIN PENALTIES AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NUMBER 1511.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS.

Section 1: INCORPORATING STANDARD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE. There is hereby incorporated by reference for the City purpose of regulating traffic within the corporate limits of the City of Columbus, Kansas, the certain standard traffic ordinance known as the "Standard Traffic Ordinance", for 2024, prepared and published in book form by the League of Kansas Municipalities. No fewer than three (3) copies of said Standard Traffic Ordinance shall be marked or stamped "Official Copy as Adopted by Ordinance 1517" and to which shall be attached a copy of this ordinance and filed with the City Clerk to be open to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours. The Police Department, Municipal Judge, City Attorney, City Prosecutor, and all administrative departments of the city charged with enforcement of the ordinance shall be supplied official copies of such Standard Traffic Ordinance similarly marked, as may be deemed expedient, at the cost of the City.

Section 2: REPEAL. Ordinance Number 1511 is hereby repealed.


Section 3: EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official city newspaper.

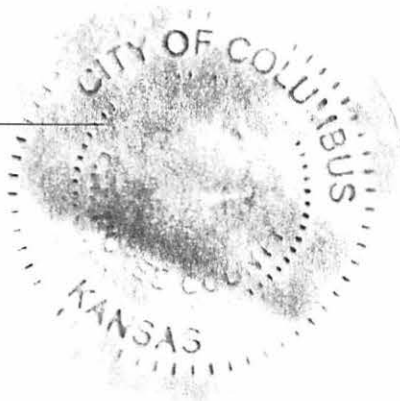
