

ORDINANCE 21-17

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DUNEDIN, FLORIDA, REPEALING SECTION 2-62 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, CITY OF DUNEDIN; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that section 2-62 of the Code of Ordinances, City of Dunedin (City Code), which was enacted in 1977, is no longer necessary as appointments to advisory boards and committees have been established by majority vote of the City Commission as part of each enabling legislation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DUNEDIN, FLORIDA, IN SESSION DULY AND REGULARLY ASSEMBLED THAT:

SECTION 1. Section 2-62 of the City Code is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. Each provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed separate and severable and if any section or part thereof is held to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and enactment.
